## SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE 2023, 2024, & 2025 ACTION PLANS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

**PUBLIC HEARING** - The City of Harrisonburg will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 409 South Main Street, in order to receive citizen input regarding amendments to the 2023, 2024, and 2025 Action Plans for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. This Action Plan serves as the City's guide for addressing overall community development and housing needs that will utilize the City's annual entitlement of CDBG funding available from HUD to meet those needs. The amendments to be considered at this Public Hearing are as follows:

- Two transfers will be made <u>to</u> the NEW Kiwanis Park project, bringing the total of the project to \$199,500:
  - \$119,500 will be moved from the Hillandale Playground project (2025-2026) to the NEW Kiwanis Park Playground project.
  - \$80,000 will be moved from the Hillandale Sidewalk project (2024-2025) to the NEW Kiwanis Park Playground project.
- \$76,867.71 will be transferred <u>from</u> the Habitat for Humanity Home Repair project (2024-2025) to the following projects, decreasing the total amount funded to the Habitat for Humanity Home Repair project to \$62,832.29:
  - \$34,760.63 will be transferred to the Ralph Sampson Park Walking Path project (2024-2025), bringing the CDBG funding of that project to a total of \$199,500.
  - \$42,107.08 will be transferred to the Wolfe St. Waterline project (2023-2024) to cover the entire cost of that project, bringing the total CDBG funding of the project to \$135,607.08.

Following the Public Hearing, there will be a 30-day Public Comment Period. All citizens and organizations are invited to attend the public hearing to comment orally or in writing on the Annual Action Plan Amendment. Special assistance is available for disabled persons addressing City Council. Efforts will be made to provide adaptations or accommodations based on individual needs of qualified individuals with disabilities, provided that notification at least five (5) business days prior to the date of the meeting has been received by the City Clerk's Office, 409 S. Main Street, 3rd Floor at 540-432-7701. Additionally, translation services may be offered upon request and availability. Written comments may be mailed to Kristin McCombe, CDBG Manager, Office of the City Manager, 409 South Main Street, Harrisonburg, VA 22801. Comments may also be submitted by calling (540) 432-8926 or emailing kristinm@harrisonburgva.gov.

In order to obtain the views of citizens, public agencies and other interested parties, the City will place this amendment to the Annual Action Plans on public display in the following locations during normal operational hours beginning on December 9, 2025:
