


# Capital Improvement Program

## FY 2026-2027 Through FY 2030-2031




- The CIP is not a budget, but a planning tool.
- Multi-year production and scheduling of capital projects of \$50,000 or greater.
- Financing plan to fund the projects.
- Projects in the CIP will likely not be funded exactly as outlined due to budgetary restraints.
- The actual commitment of funds for any capital item is approved through the annual budget.


# FY27-31 Total CIP Request by Fund



# FY27-31 Total CIP Request by Fund




# FY27-31 Total CIP Requested by Department




# FY27-31 Total CIP Request by Department
