Westover Skate Park Replacement - Background

\$475,000

- Contract with American Ramp Company entered into on 1/5/2023
- Skate Park Demolition on 4/17/2023
- Directed to reach out to other potential contractors on July 25, 2023

Community Engagement



Committed to working with the community in whatever way the City sees fit in order to design the skate park. ARC will send a design team that includes two professional skaters, one of which is also an Olympic skater, to conduct in person design meetings. Final design upon consensus from stakeholders.



Public engagement strategy will consist of social media presence where input can be gathered as well as 1 or 2 public input meetings in the City of Harrisonburg. Meetings may also take place virtually, especially any meeting after the initial in person meeting which changes an initial design.

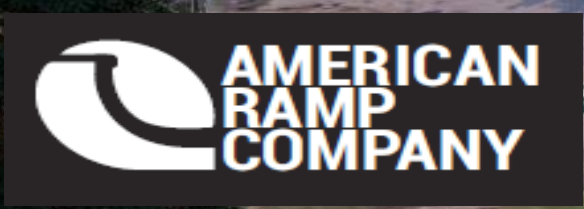


Public engagement typically consists of online surveys coupled with public input, in-person workshops. Their goal is to work with the community of multiple stakeholders until they reach consensus for a final design. Their process can be modified to fit the City's needs.

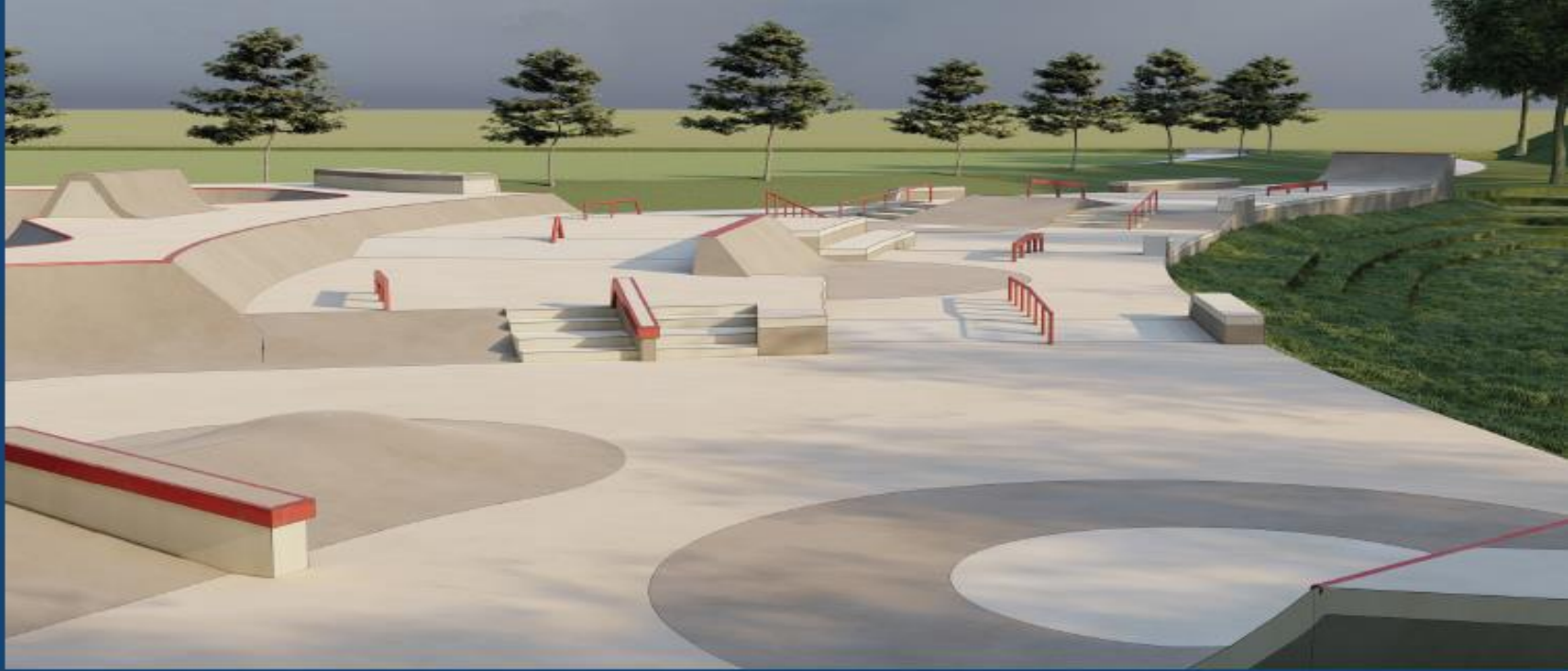
