



**A PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING MARCH 8, 2026 AS  
INTERNATIONAL WOMEN’S DAY**

THEREFORE, on behalf of the City of Harrisonburg, I, Deanna Reed, along with the entire Council, do hereby proclaim March 8th as International Women’s Day in the City of Harrisonburg. We invite the community to join the annual commemoration of International Women’s Day on the Saturday closest to March 8th.

Together, let us continue building a community where everyone belongs and everyone can succeed.
