The Foundation has continued to maintain its certification in all subsequent reviews which has enabled it to gain and maintain donor, nonprofit, and community confidence that the organization is operated according to the highest standards.

I believe that my education and career opportunities and experiences have provided me with a background that would enable me to add valuable insights related to the mission, direction and operations of the Commission.
