RE: Resolution for VDOT Revenue Sharing Grant – Grace Street Extension Project and Garbers Church

Road Shared Use Path Project

<u>Summary:</u> The Public Works Department is requesting City Council to consider adopting a Resolution for the Grace Street Extension Project and Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path Project, which will both be funded through the VDOT Revenue Sharing Grant Program.

Background: VDOT Revenue Sharing is a grant program that allows Localities to request VDOT to contribute 50% of project development costs for transportation related capital projects. The Grace Street Extension project is in partnership with James Madison University, and JMU will be providing the required 50% matching funds for this project. The Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path project is a current Revenue Sharing project, where additional funds are needed in order to construct the shared use path from Bluestone Elementary/Harrisonburg High Schools to the cul de sac on Wyndham Woods Drive.
