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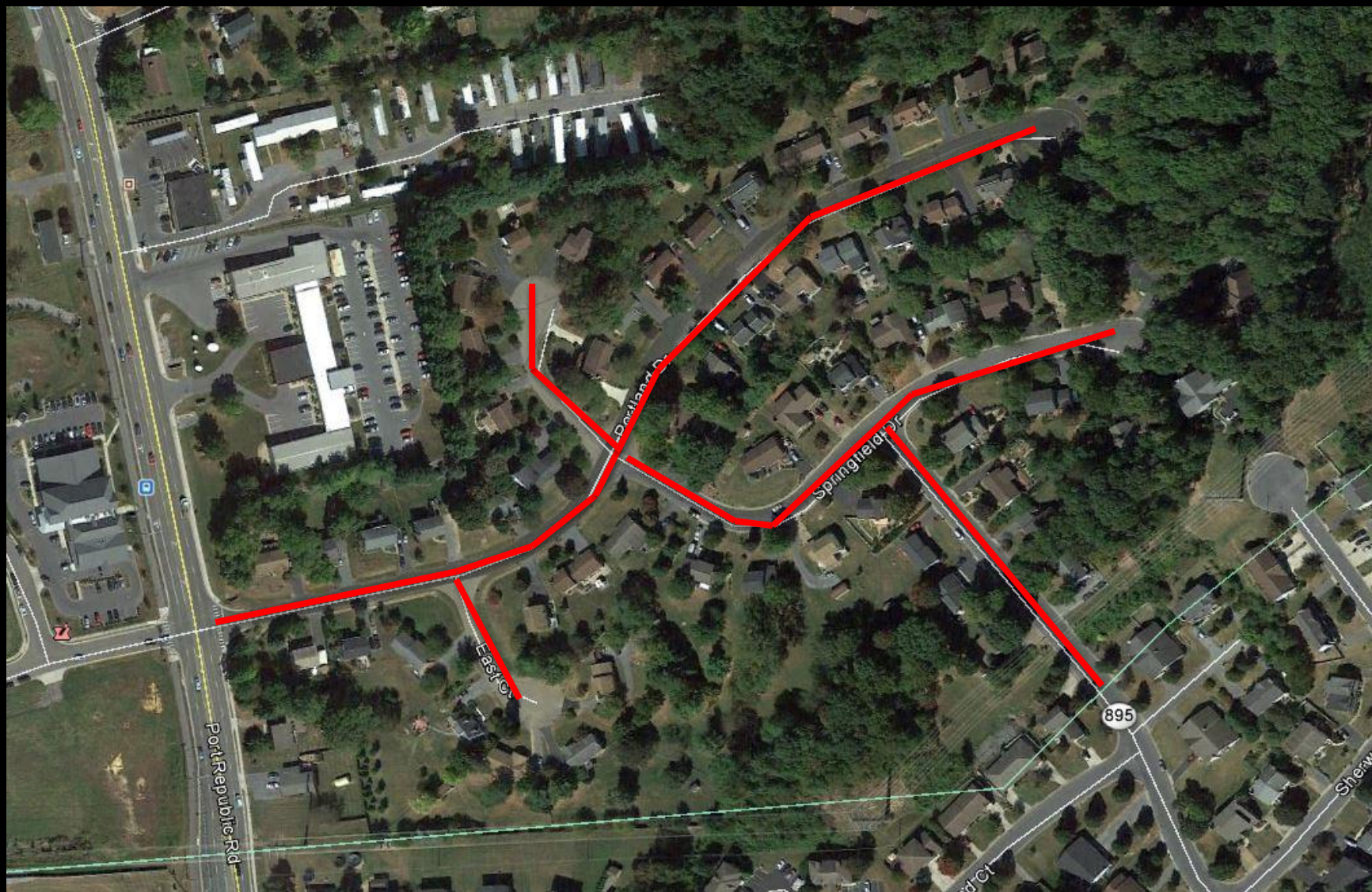
Timeframe

- December 2017 – Increased Enforcement
- December 2017 – Team Up to Slow Down Campaign
- April 2018 – Neighborhood Meeting
- April 2018 – Council Approved Traffic Study
- May 2018 – Study Complete and Petition Process
- May 2018 – Required Signatures Received
- June 2018 – Seeking Enrollment

Traffic Study Summary

- May 2018 Study:
 - ADT > 600 vehicles per day
 - 85th Percentile Speeds > 35 mph
 - Documented Cut-Through Traffic
 - Documented Stop Sign Violations
- Fieldale Place, Portland Drive, Springfield Drive, East Court, West Court
- Established Neighborhood Area

Next Steps

- Summer 2018 – Neighborhood Meetings to Development Traffic Calming Plan
- Fall 2018 – Finalize Traffic Calming Plan (incl's Public Comment Period)
- Fall 2018 – Transportation Safety and Advisory Commission Recommendation
- Fall/Winter 2018/2019– Council Approval of Plan
- Fall/Winter 2018/2019 – Begin Implementation
- Future – Study, Revise, Implement, etc.
