RE: Supplemental Appropriation – Police and Parks & Recreation

**Summary:** Consider a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$80,926.38 for the Police and Parks & Recreation Departments.

**Background:** This supplemental appropriation will appropriate a total of \$80,926.38.

- \$17,524.63 in State Asset Forfeiture Funds that will be used to purchase an electric golf cart which will be utilized for downtown events. The current carts are older models that do not have a roof cover and only seat two individuals. The new cart will have a cover and seat four individuals.
- \$63,401.75 in Reserved Fund Balance funds that will be used to repair the liner of the irrigation pond.

**Key Issues:** The City regularly receives asset forfeiture funds which can only be used for law enforcement purposes. There is currently a balance in the state asset forfeiture funds in excess of this request. In addition, funding was provided in the fiscal year 2013 budget for the golf course to repair and improve the irrigation pond. At that time, the work to repair and improve the irrigation pond was not accomplished. Subsequently, City Council approved for these funds to be placed in a reserve account for future use to make the necessary repairs as needed.

**Environmental Impact:** None.

Fiscal Impact: The total city budget will increase \$80,926.38.

**<u>Prior Actions:</u>** City Council approved reserving the golf course funds at its June 25, 2013 meeting.

Alternatives: Do not approve the supplemental appropriation request.

**Community Engagement:** N/A.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends approval of the supplemental appropriation.
