- January 11, 2021 **Advertise RFP** in DNR & on website for grant proposals. Send application and information to email distribution list.
- January 14, 2021 **VIRTUAL Training Session** for CDBG Applicants – **2:00pm**
- January 26, 2021 **Council Meeting/Public Hearing #1** (get input regarding what types of projects should be funded, what need is, explain purpose of grant and answer questions) – **7PM**
- February 25, 2021 **Grant Application Deadline** – receipt by **NOON**
- March 11, 2021 **Selection Committee Meeting, Consideration of Proposals, & Development of Action Plan**
- March 23, 2021 **Council Meeting/Public Hearing #2** (Present Budget, 2021 Action Plan, & open 30 day Public Comment Period – **7:00 PM**
- April 26, 2021 **All public comments must be received by 9:00 AM on April 26, 2021 to be considered.**
- May 11, 2021 **Council Meeting/Council Final Approval of 2021 CDBG Budget/Action Plan** (Council to consider approval of budget/Annual Action Plan)*
- May 15, 2021 **Annual Action Plan due to HUD**
- June 2021 **HUD Approval of 2021 CDBG Action Plan**
