March 11, 2021	Selection Committee Meeting, Consideration of Proposals, & Development of Action Plan
March 23, 2021	Council Meeting/Public Hearing #2 (Present Budget, 2021 Action Plan, & open 30 day Public Comment Period – 7:00 PM
April 26, 2021	All public comments must be received by 9:00 AM on April 26, 2021 to be considered.
May 11, 2021	Council Meeting/Council Final Approval of 2021 CDBG Budget/Action Plan (Council to consider approval of budget/Annual Action Plan)*
May 15, 2021	Annual Action Plan due to HUD
June 2021	HUD Approval of 2021 CDBG Action Plan
