

**RESOLUTION CONSIDERING VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FY2019 REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM APPLICATION**

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Harrisonburg City Council held on Tuesday August 27, 2019, on a motion by Councilmember Baugh, seconded by Councilmember Romero, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of 4 to 0:

WHEREAS, the CITY OF HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL desires to submit an application for an allocation of funds of up to \$4,738,279.50 through the Virginia Department of Transportation Fiscal Year 2020-21, Revenue Sharing Program; and,


WHEREAS, \$4,738,279.50 are requested to fund the realignment of University Blvd from the Carrier Drive to Port Republic Road. An urban 2-lane roadway with shared use path and sidewalk is proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby supports this application for an allocation of \$4,738,279.50 through the Virginia Department of Transportation Revenue Sharing Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby ensures that the required 50% local match funds will be provided for any approved revenue sharing grants,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby grants authority for the City Manager to execute project administration agreements for any approved revenue sharing projects.
