# Timeframe

- March 2015 – Increased Enforcement
- May 2015 – Team Up to Slow Down Campaign
- June 2015 – Neighborhood Meeting
- July 2015 – Council Approved Traffic Study
- December 2015 – Study Complete and Petition Process
- May 2018 – Required Signatures Received
- June 2018 – Seeking Enrollment

# Traffic Study Summary

- October 2015 Study:
  - ADT > 600 vehicles per day
  - 85<sup>th</sup> Percentile Speeds > 35 mph
  - Documented Cut-Through Traffic
- Maryland, Dogwood, Chestnut, Willow, and Grace
- Established Neighborhood Area
