<u>Summary:</u> The Public Works Department and Public Utilities Department will provide a presentation on a new Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) called CityWorks.

**Background:** Beginning in 2014 the City released a Request for Information in order to determine if a Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) would be beneficial to the City. A CMMS is a computerized method of both tracking costs (equipment, labor, and materials) and the condition of assets. It was determined that a CMMS was needed; the City then released a Request for Proposal for a consultant to provide and implement the CMMS in the City. The City selected the Timmons Group to implement the CMMS and selected CityWorks as the CMMS program. Since then the Department of Public Utilities has fully implemented CityWorks and is working through a maturity plan for further implementation. The Department of Public Works has implemented the Stormwater and Street Maintenance divisions, and is currently working on the Traffic Division.
