Dear Alison,

The new high school located on Route 11 South will have approximately 646 spaces including 23 ADA spaces. Of this total, 610 spaces are adjacent to the school providing for student/faculty parking. It is estimated that approximately 200 staff members will work in the building. Not all of that total will be in the building every day or for the entire day. The additional 36 spaces are in athletic parking.

Visitor parking will be limited to the northwest parking lot. Student drop off will be adjacent to the front of the building. These two areas will be separated by staggered islands.

An additional 50 on-street parking spaces will be constructed as part of the new public street. While these parking spaces are not located on site, they are located adjacent to the athletic facilities and will be available for use by the school and visitors providing for additional parking during school events.
