RESOLUTION INCREASING THE NUMBER OF COMMISSIONERS, APPOINTING TWO NEW COMMISSIONERS, AND FILLING ONE VACANCY OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HARRISONBURG REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia requires a city or county to appoint not more than nine or less than five persons as commissioners of the housing authority created for such city or county; and

WHEREAS, Section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia further authorizes the governing body to subsequently increase the number of commissioners of the authority to a maximum of nine; and

WHEREAS, Section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia further authorizes the governing body to fill all vacancies of the board of commissioners for the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, the Harrisonburg Redevelopment and Housing Authority presently has five commissioners, including one vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia wishes to expand the number of commissioners from five to seven, appoint two new commissioners, and fill the current vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA:

- 1. That **Christine Fasching Maphis** is appointed to fill the existing vacancy, which shall expire on November 29, 2022;
- 2. That **Kevin Coffman** is appointed commissioner for an initial term of three years, which shall expire on November 29, 2023; and
- 3. That **Luciano Benjamin** be appointed commissioner for an initial term of four years, which shall expire on November 29, 2024.
