## **Summary:**

## **Changes since first draft:**

Page 2 – added "Taxes – Short-term Rentals" (AirBnB) position statement to support appropriate regulation and taxation for AirBnB's.

Page 3- added "Educational Funding – ESL" position statement to support additional funding that recognizes Harrisonburg's higher ESL levels.

Page 3 – added "Transportation Funding – Roadway Maintenance Payments" position statement to oppose reduction in funding when roadways converted to bike lanes.

Page 4 – added under "Other Legislative Positions" a statement supporting reduced budget cuts to James Madison University.
