

**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR ROCKINGHAM COUNTY
SMART SCALE ROUND 4 GRANT APPLICATION**

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Harrisonburg City Council held on Tuesday July 28, 2020, on a motion by ^{Council} Richard Baugh, seconded by Councilman Hirschman, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of 4 to 0:

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia prioritizes transportation projects for funding based on the cost effectiveness of those projects to meet performance goals, as established by the Smart Scale program; and

WHEREAS, Rockingham County intends to submit an application to increase the widths of the existing travel lanes and add shoulders along Route 720 (Smithland Road) between U.S. 11 (North Valley Pike) and Route 718 (Old Furnace Road), to improve safety, operations, and bicycle movement; and

WHEREAS, the east terminus of the project is located approximately 250' inside the City boundary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby supports this application for the improvements described to compete for state and federal funding under the Smart Scale program.
