

ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 4-2-19
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

That Section 4-2-19. Assessment of costs in criminal and traffic cases for the costs of an electronic summons system.

There is hereby imposed and assessed by the city, subject to the provisions of Section 17.1-279.1 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, an additional fee of five dollars (\$5.00) as part of the costs in each criminal and traffic case prosecuted on a city warrant or summons, in either the circuit court, general district court, or juvenile and domestic relations district court. The clerk of the court in which the warrant or summons is filed shall collect these assessments and remit them to the city treasurer. The treasurer shall hold the funds subject to disbursements by the city council to the city police department solely to fund software, hardware, and associated equipment costs for the implementation and maintenance of an electronic summons system.

This ordinance shall be effective from the 1st day of December, 2015.
