

**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE MOUNT CLINTON PIKE ROAD
IMPROVEMENTS**

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Harrisonburg City Council held on Tuesday September 27, 2016, on a motion by Abe Shearer, seconded by Richard Baugh, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of 5 to 0 :

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia now prioritizes transportation projects for funding based on the cost effectiveness of those projects to meet performance goals, as established by the Smart Scale program; and

WHEREAS, the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL desires to submit an application for an allocation of funds for the Mount Clinton Road Improvements project under the Smart Scale prioritization program; and

WHEREAS, Mount Clinton Pike is identified in the VTRANS 2040 Needs Assessment as part of the Regional Network; and

WHEREAS, the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL understands this project to include the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Mt. Clinton Pike, Park Road, and Chicago Avenue to eliminate an offset intersection, the reconstruction of Mt. Clinton Pike from the roundabout to Virginia Avenue (SR42), to include a shared-use-path on the north side of the road, and sidewalk on the south side; and


WHEREAS, the City has already begun the design process for this project and is committed to delivery;
