- (2) Amending and re-enacting Section13-1-69 Parking of Commercial Vehicles near residences to prohibit certain types of vehicles, such as commercial vehicles, travel trailers, as well as dumpsters and self storage containers from parking on the street in front of residences for a period longer than thirty (30) minutes. expand and clarify the types of vehicles that may not be parked near residences.
