Mosaic Development

- The Community Mosaic Project began in February 2025 to honor the 25th anniversary of OASIS Fine Art & Craft.
- The theme of the project is: What do you like best about the Harrisonburg area.
- Community members had the opportunity to request 16" x 24" panels from OASIS and also received all of the supplies-- including glass pieces, equipment, glue, bandaids-- and training.
- Completed panels then were returned to OASIS to be grouted.
- The project concluded in September 2025 with over 80 panels and more than 6,000 people contributing to the panels' creation.
