I am also the current Vice President & Co-Founder of The Gomez Noriega Family Foundation which is a Non- profit organization created to help children from low-income families through the sport of swimming. There I developed a program currently assisting over 100 children ages 5 to 14 with transportation, access to the pool and a swimming coach. We raised over 10,000 USD to provide stipends to families in need of additional financial support for various household items, the contributions come from a different number of sponsors they range from \$100-\$500 per month. I have previously worked as the Undergraduate Assistant for International Advising Williamsburg with the Reves Center for International where I advised on international issues and budget relating to international students. I also in charge of the administration and allocation of funds and scholarships. In my time there my team and I were able to increased number of international student body by 7% through strategic marketing strategies. Adding on, I worked as the Finance Supervisor with the Virginia Executive Appropriations Committee where we manage budget of the Student Assembly, oversaw the funding of over 100,000 USD in concerts, competitions, conferences and activities. We also structured a special fund for the Steer Clear Program which is aimed towards eliminating drunk driving and risky behavior on and around our campus.
