Bicycle Parking Regulations



The amendments include:

- To add minimum off-street bicycle parking regulations, where the requirement varies depending upon the use on the parcel (single family detached or duplex units would have no minimum requirements);
- To add specifications for bicycle parking plan submittals;
- To modify the existing definition of "off-street parking" to refer to both vehicle and bicycle parking;
- To amend Section 10-3-28 to clarify rules for computing the required number of minimum parking spaces;
- To amend multiple sections in the ZO to clarify that the existing regulations noted in the sections refer only to vehicle parking spaces: Sections 10-3-26, 29, 34, 40, 46, 48.4, 52, 55.4, 56.4, 57.4, 58.4, 79, 91, 97, 106, and 180.
- Modify the DCSM Section 2.6.10 by amending the existing language to reference the ZO and by adding drawings to assist developers in meeting the proposed requirements.

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






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

- 2. BICYCLE RACK DESIGN AND LAYOUT SHALL BE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE "BICYCLE PARKING GUIDELINES" AS ADOPTED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PROFFESSIONALS (WWW.APBP.ORG). OTHER RACK STYLES MEETING THESE GUIDELINES ARE ACCEPTABLE.

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Rationale for Amendments

 DCSM enforces requirements for development and redevelopment projects only

 Currently, DCSM requires same ratio of bicycle parking spaces for all uses

"Bicycle Parking Guidelines" is not readily available

Proposed Amendments address short-term bicycle parking only

 Bicycle parking is not required in the B-1, Central Business District. However, if bicycle parking is provided in B-1, property owners must comply with design requirements
