# APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES FROM CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VA TO FACILITIES LOCATED IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY AUTHORIZATION OF REVIEW

City Code of Ordinance Section 7-2-4(e) states, "The Director may charge a reasonable fee to cover time and expenses of processing the application". The following policy shall be used to distribute the expenses incurred by the Department of Public Utilities.

- 1. <u>Initial Review:</u> There shall be no charge to execute the "Application and Acknowledgement" form used to initiate the review process by City and County officials. There shall be no charge to provide the first response to the "Application for Public Utilities From City of Harrisonburg, Virginia to Facilities Located in Rockingham County: Code of Ordinance 7-2-4". It should be recognized that the first response may be a letter of recommendation for approval or disapproval, or, it may provide stipulations for additional information or engineering evaluation.
- 2. <u>Continued Review</u>: Under circumstances progressing beyond the initial review, the Department shall invoice the applicant for specific cost as incurred. Upon request, the Department may provide a non-binding estimate for the applicant to consider. The costs shall include, but are not limited to: processing, consulting and support as applied directly to the management of the application.

"Processing costs" - shall only include the time of the "application officer" to handle, coordinate, evaluate, review and manage the process until the application has been closed; unit billing rate shall be \$28.55/hour.

"Consulting costs" - shall refer to contracted, or in-house, hydraulic modeling performed to evaluate the water or sewer system impact. Contracted cost shall be forwarded at invoice costs. In house engineering rate shall be at \$34.55/hour.

"Support costs" - shall refer to the collection of information by field technicians billed at the rate accepted to # person crew used.

I have reviewed the Bailey Family Farms application for City water service to 59 Bank Church Road and I am recommending approval of the connection. The applicant is constructing a new turkey house and requests a 1" metered connection to the City's rural potable system at the intersection of Bank Church Road and Rawley Pike. A map is attached for your reference. The flow rate of the requested connection is insignificant in our distribution system and requires no infrastructure improvement. The connection is also favorable in the perspective that the service can be provided from the Water Treatment Plant by gravity without expending electrical energy to transmit the flow. The connection is nearly ideal to market the available capacity in the water system.

The applicant is aware that they are responsible for acquiring permissions to operate a service line from the meter location to their point of use. This includes crossing neighboring properties as well as crossing a state-maintained road. The applicant claims to have a service line already installed and approved for this purpose.

The applicant states that this service will be the primary water supply for the poultry operation and will utilize an on-site well as a backup supply. This gives concern for contamination of the public water supply. As a mitigation, I would require the installation and maintenance of a backflow preventor as a condition to install and maintain the public water supply connection. If the applicant fails to install or maintain such device, the service will be discontinued and disconnected from the public water supply to protect the system.

The connection is proposed within the 33 West corridor where we are engaged in the reassignment of existing assets. I recommend this connection be installed on the existing 12" waterline located on the near side of the street rather than the 10" on the far side. The service can be relocated to the adjacent 16" waterline as other local services are also moved to the 16".

To Whom it May Concern:

We are requesting approval for a utility water hook up for a Pilgrim's Poultry Breeder house. This would be our main source of water and we need this water source to run the breeder operation on our property. Thank you for your consideration in this matter.
