Summary:

STATUTORY AUTHORITY. Section 601 of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states the following:

No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

FTA requires that all direct and primary recipients document their compliance by submitting a Title VI Program to their FTA regional civil rights officer once every three years. The Title VI Program must be approved by the direct or primary recipient's appropriate governing entity. The Title VI Program for the Harrisonburg Department of Public Transportation (HDPT) is for the period that includes FY2022 through FY2024.
