- Through the National Parks Service
- Funded by the Historic Preservation Fund
- Funds physical preservation projects for historic sites
- \$5 million appropriated for HER
- Eligible sites include those listed in or determined eligible for the National Register of Historic Places or as a National Historic Landmark

What This Project Will Do

1. Remove rust from windows
2. Reglaze windows and caulk around windows with cracks
3. Apply rust inhibitor primer to windows
4. Repaint the windows
5. Install storm windows with matching paint color

The project will not remove, replace, or alter components of the Simms Center. It will protect and preserve the building, ensuring that it will serve as a valuable asset for generations to come.
