WHERE DID WE END UP?

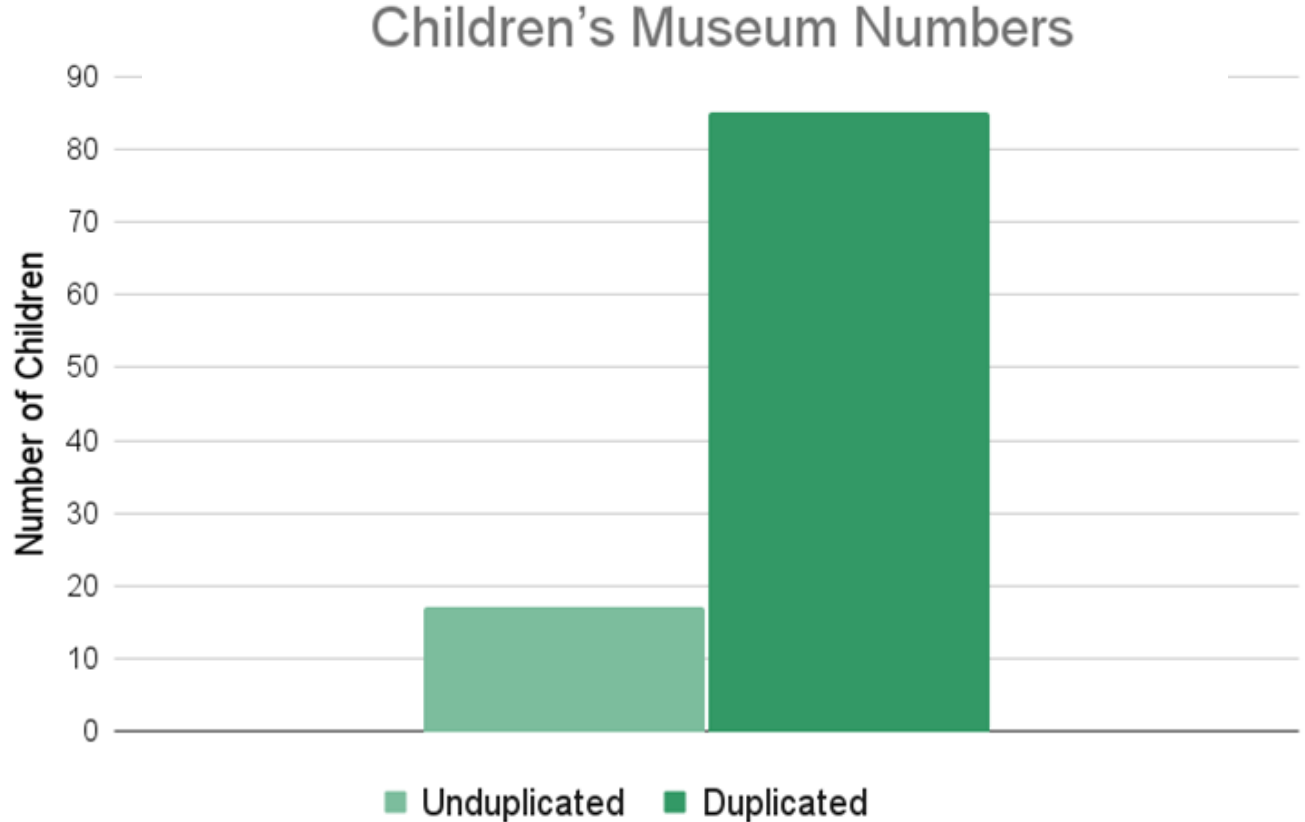
- 539 youth reached last school year

MISCONCEPTIONS

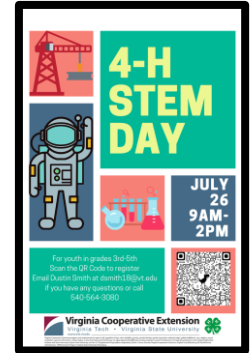
Duplicated vs

- Lots of positive feedback

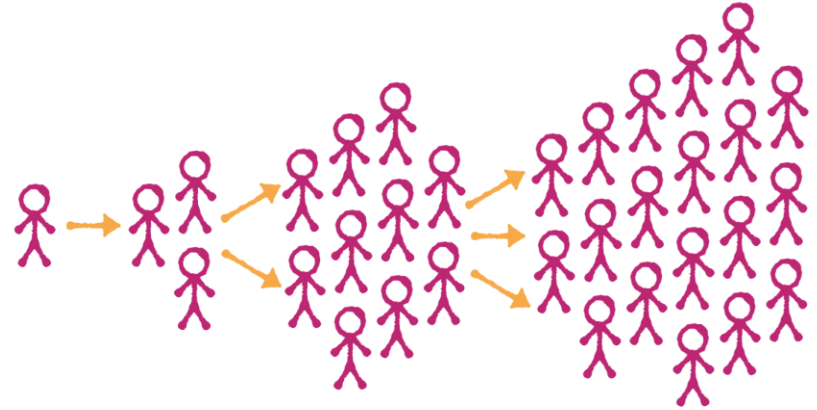
