

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**ON AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 2, FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION,  
SECTIONS 5-2-18, 5-2-19, AND 5-2-20 OF THE CITY OF HARRISONBURG CITY  
CODE**

The Harrisonburg City Council will hold a public hearing on April 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon as the agenda permits, in the City Council Chambers located at 409 South Main Street, Harrisonburg, Virginia, to solicit public comments concerning the following:

Amending and re-enacting Section 5-2-18, Section 5-2-19 and Section 5-2-20 to change “mulch” to “combustible landscape cover material”, to amend Section 5-2-19 to eliminate the mandate to use stone or gravel within eighteen (18) inches of combustible siding, and to amend section 5-2-20 to eliminate the Ordinance effective date of July 1, 2016 and to prohibit adding new combustible landscape cover material within eighteen (18) inches of buildings with combustible siding.

Copies of the proposed ordinances are available on the City’s website and are available in the City Manager’s Office, 409 South Main Street, Harrisonburg, Virginia, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p. m.

All persons interested will have an opportunity to express their views at this public hearing.

Any person requiring auxiliary aids, including signers, in connection with this public hearing shall notify the City Manager at least five (5) days prior to the time of the hearing.
