




Figure 3: Number of Homeless Episodes

- 48% have duration ≥ 1 yr OR frequency ≥ 3
- 5% have frequency ≥ 3 AND duration ≥1 yr




Figure 5: Reasons for Becoming Homeless

For US, 62% of homeless population were men & 38% women (2010 data, Subs. Abuse & Mental Health Admin.).




Figure 7: Gender & Homelessness

For US, 10% of homeless population was 18-24 years in age (OneCPD data from HUD, 2013).




Figure 9: Age & Homelessness

Note: Duration of current episode of homelessness is used.






Figure 10: Ethnicity


For Harrisonburg, 70% of total population is White/Caucasion, 8% Black/African American, 17% Hispanic/Latino (Census data).




Figure 13: Incarceration History




Figure 15: Ease of Getting Health Support

Note: Bars show percentages. Answers are based on self-identified health status.




Figure 16: ER Visits & Hospitalizations

Note: Bars show percentages.




Figure 17: Physical Health Conditions

Note: Bars show percentages.




Figure 18: Treatment for Mental Health Illness




Figure 19: Substance Abuse




Figure 20: Services

For US, 12% of homeless adults are veterans (OneCPD data from HUD, 2013).




Figure 22: Veterans & Homelessness

Note: Duration is for current homeless episode.




Figure 23: Homeless Veterans & Employment




Figure 24: Homeless Veterans & Health Support

Note: Duration is for Current Homeless Episode.




Figure 25: Homeless Veterans & Use of VA Hospitals




Figure 26: Homeless Veterans & Health Insurance
