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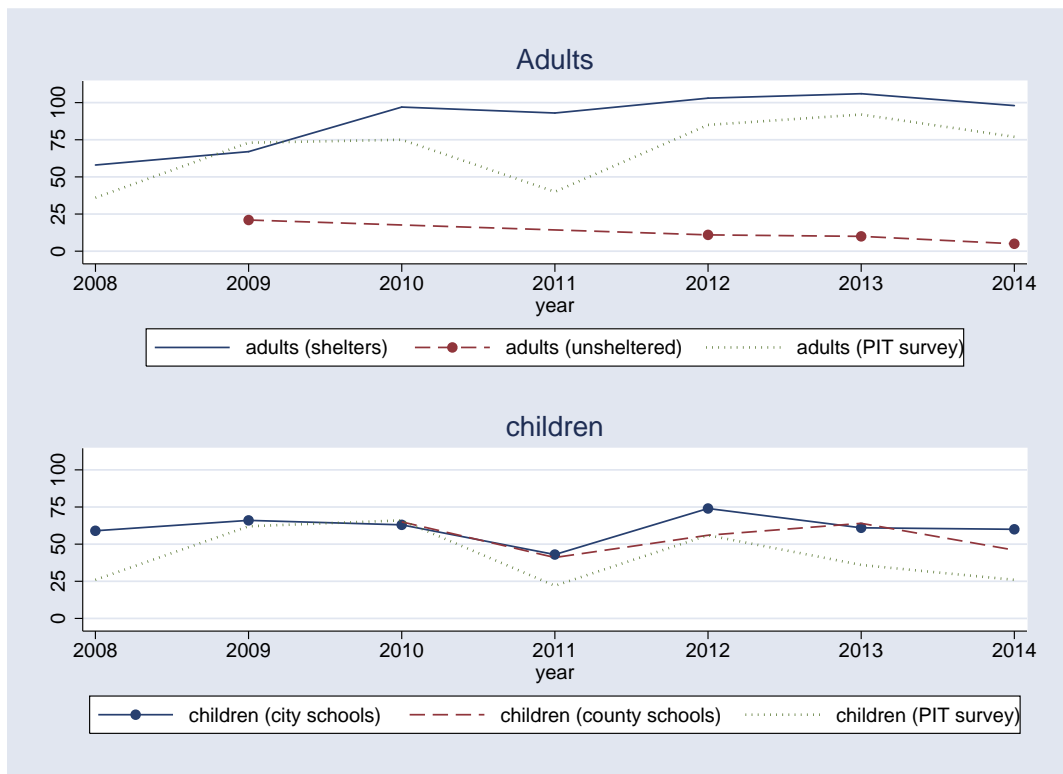

Figure 2: Duration of Homelessness

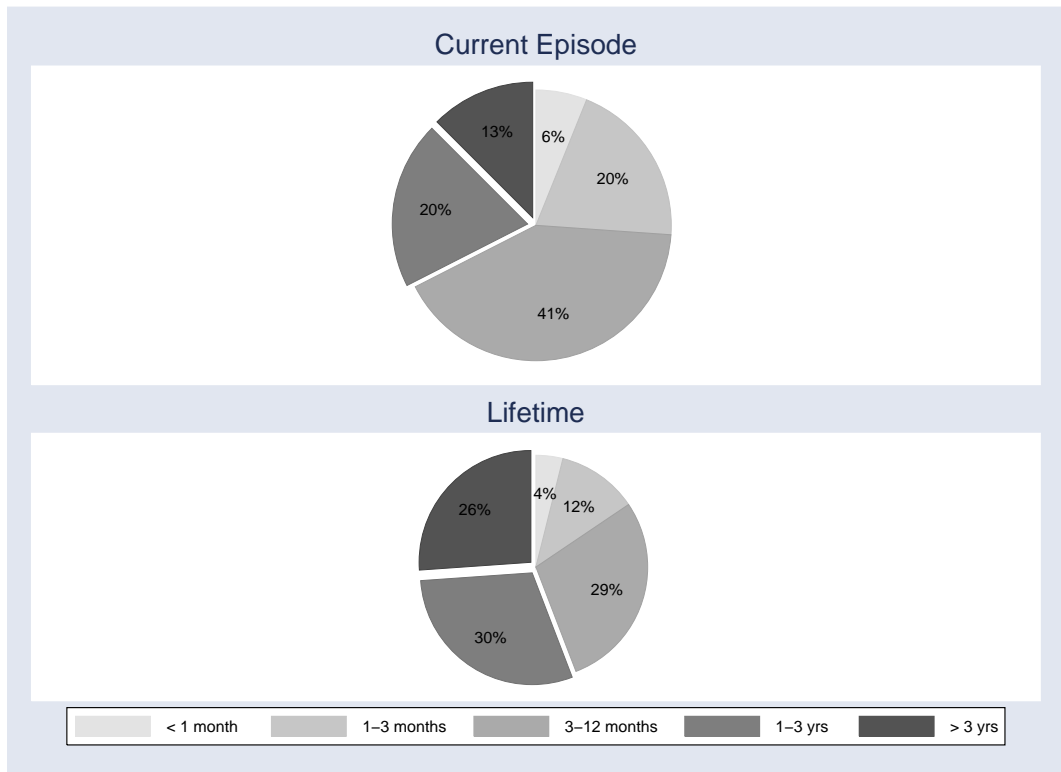
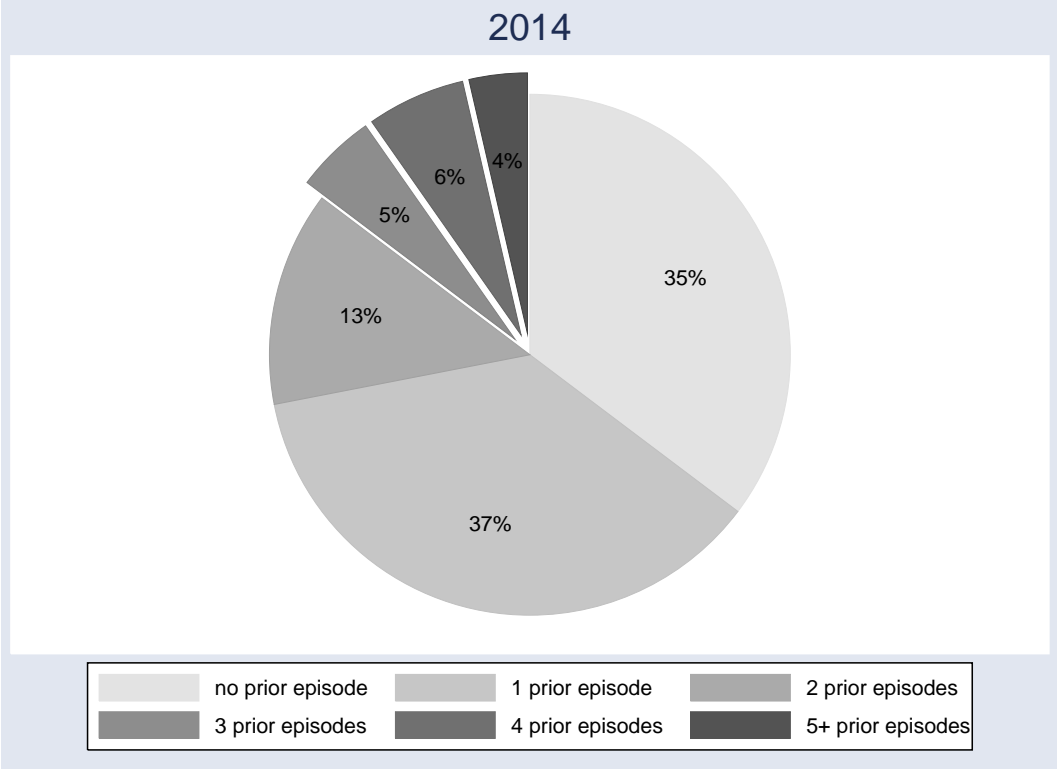
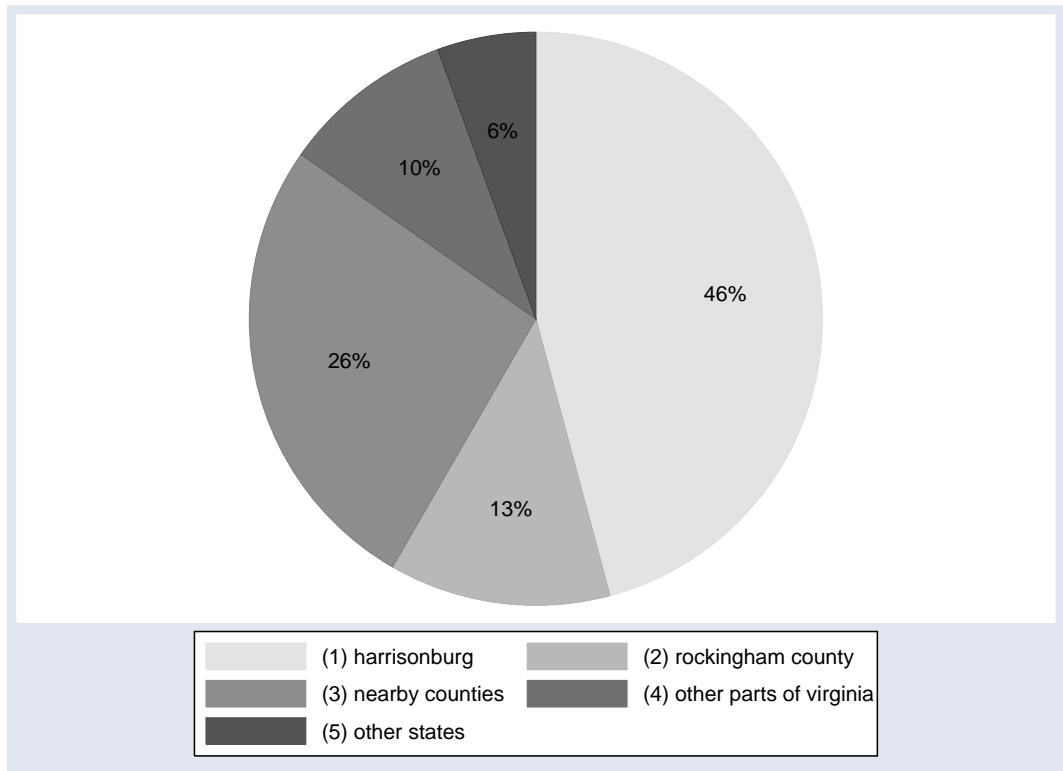


Figure 3: Number of Homeless Episodes



Note: Figures are for number of separate episodes in last 3 years.

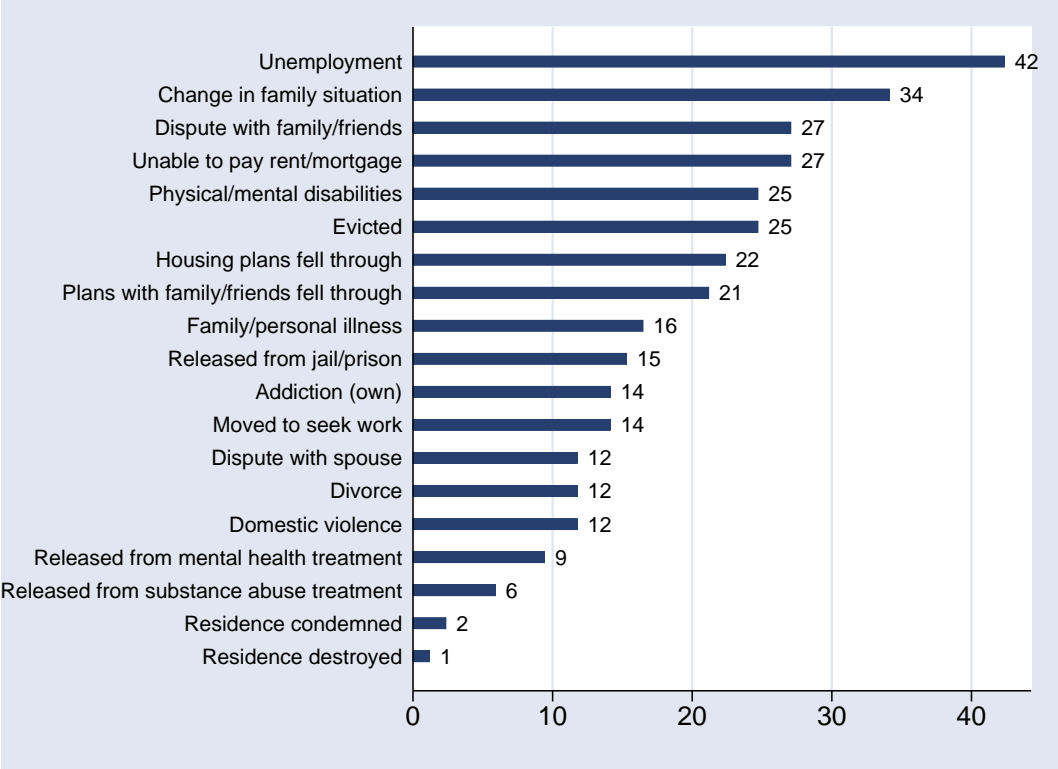
Figure 4: Previous Housing Location

- 5% have frequency ≥ 3 AND duration ≥ 1 yr

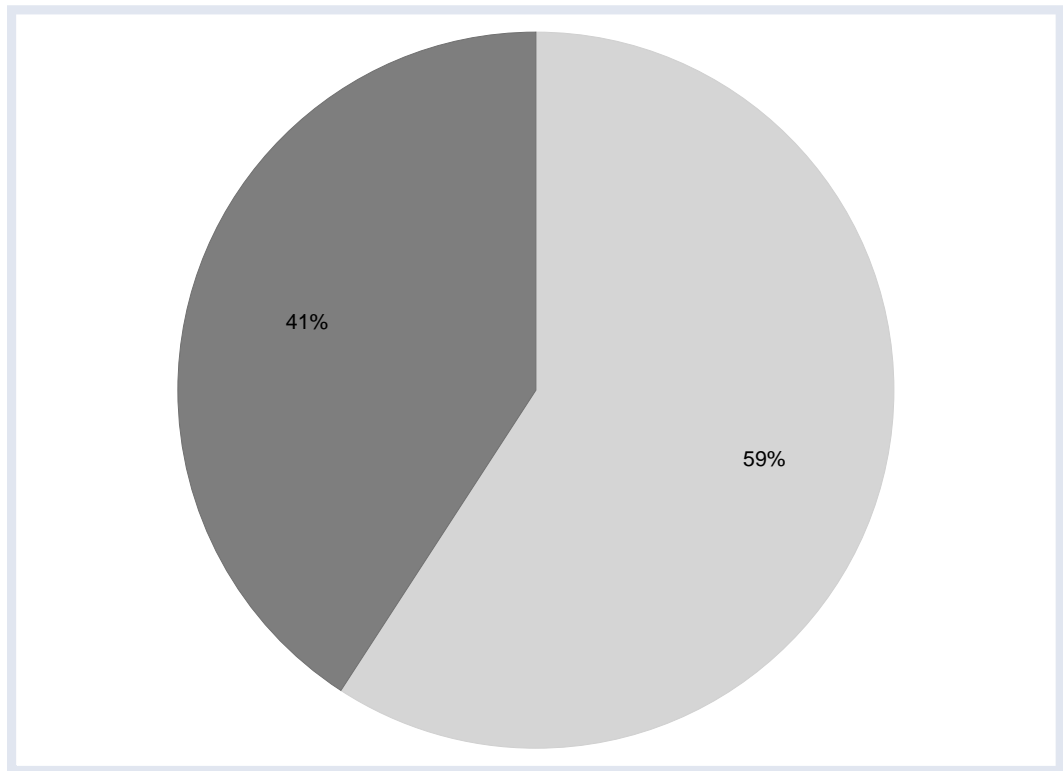
Figure 5: Reasons for Becoming Homeless



Note: Bars give percentages. Bars do not add up to 100% because individuals could give multiple answers.

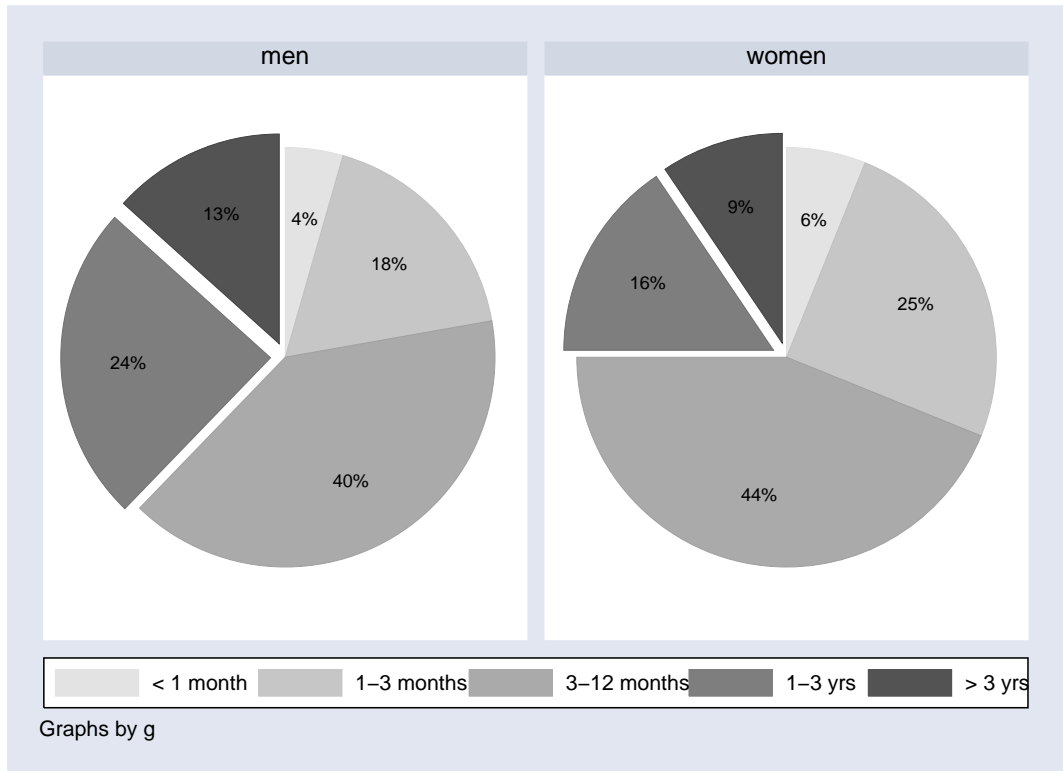

Figure 6: Gender



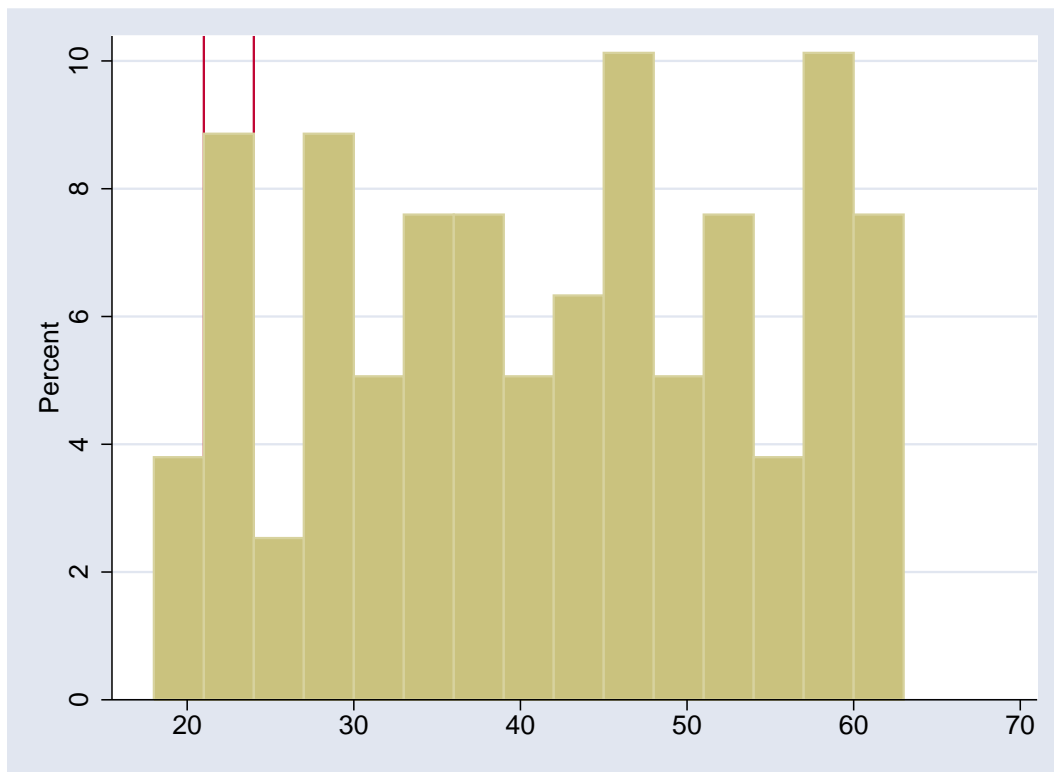
For US, 62% of homeless population were men & 38% women (2010 data, Subs. Abuse & Mental Health Admin.).

Note: Duration of current episode of homelessness is used.

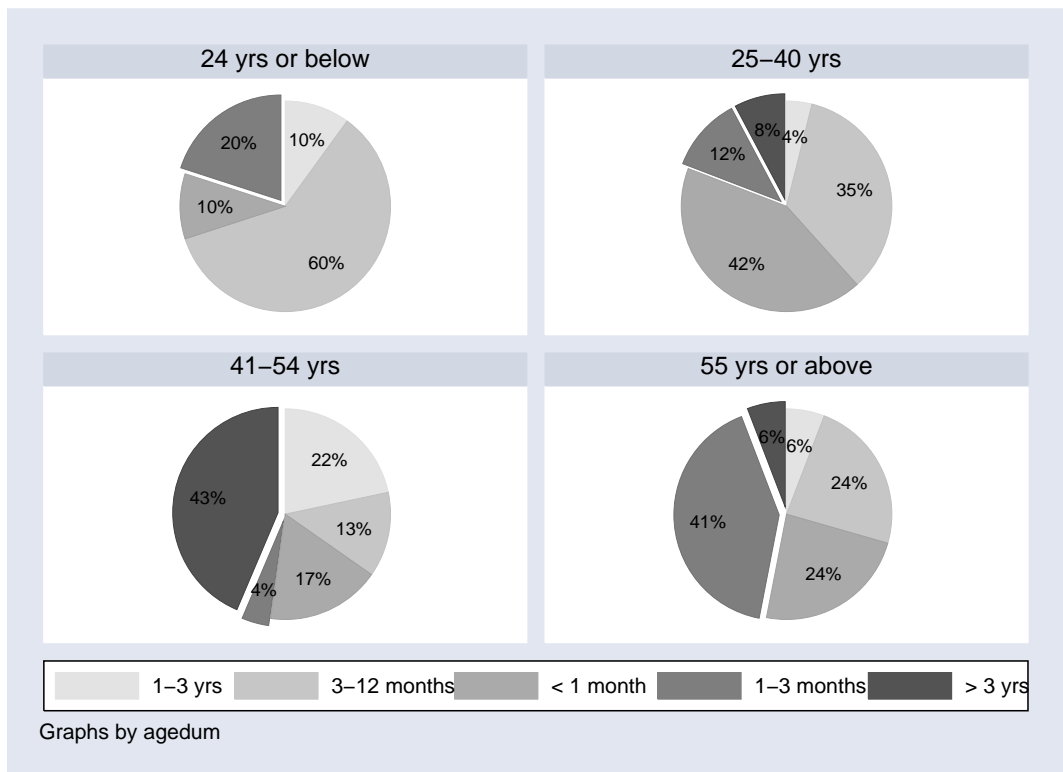
Figure 8: Age



Note: Age is in years. Bins are of width 3. Vertical lines are for 21 yrs and 24 yrs. Average is 41 yrs.

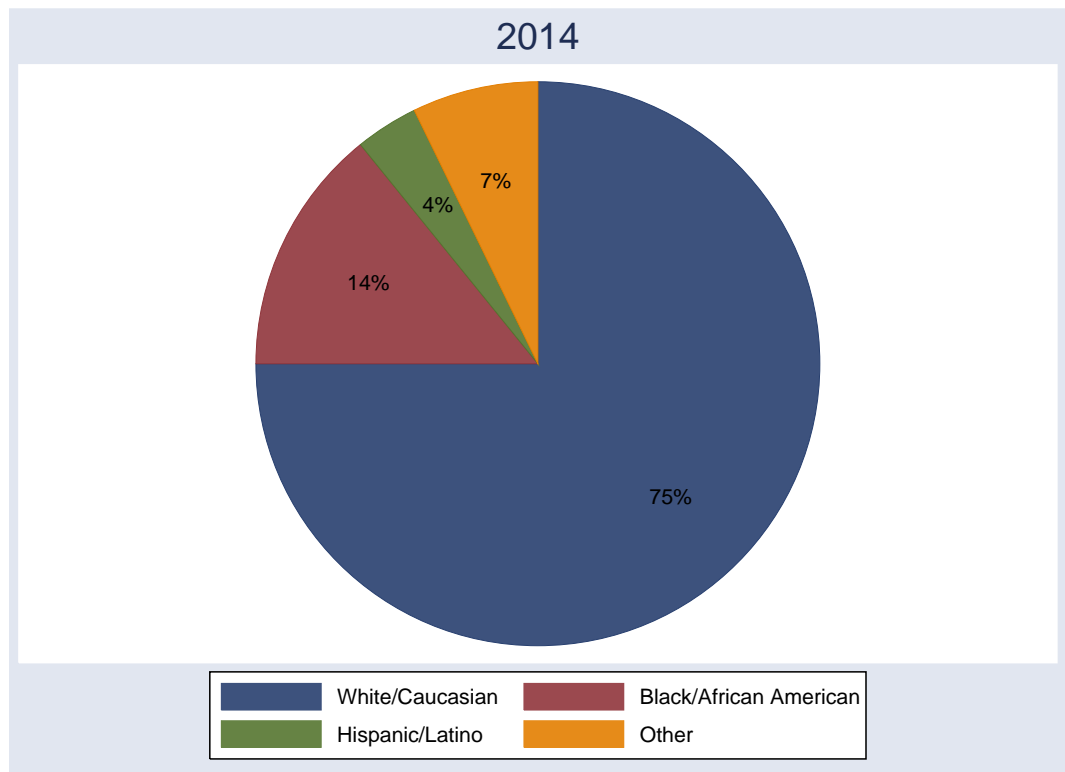

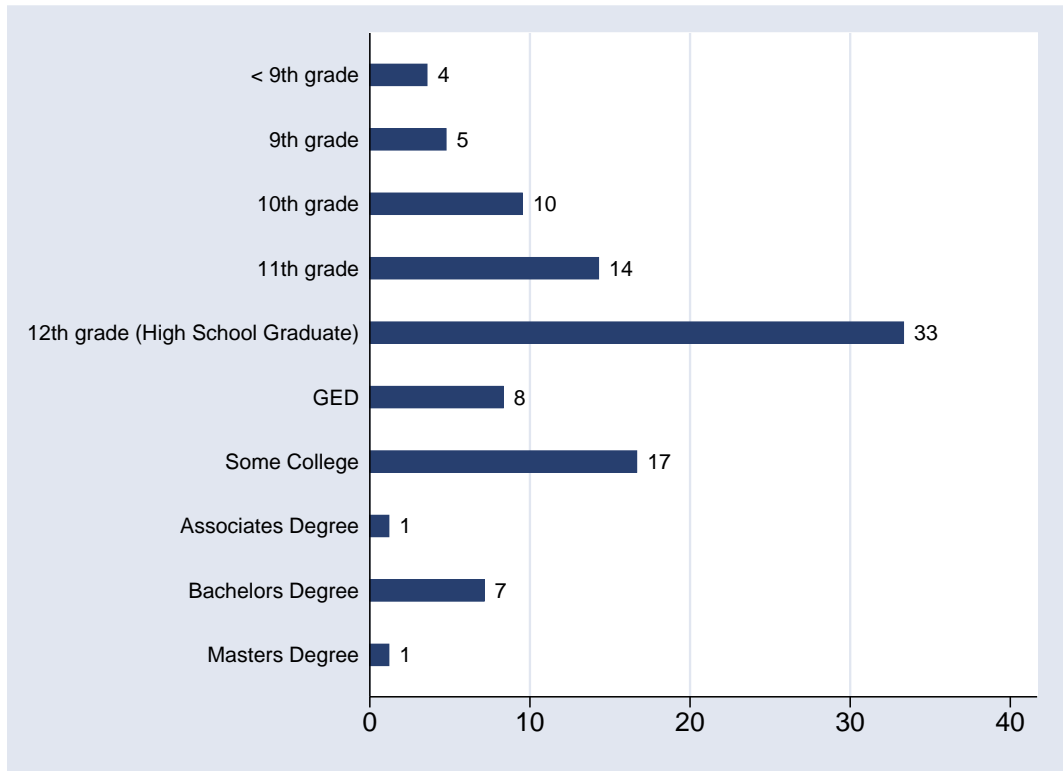


Figure 12: Employment Status

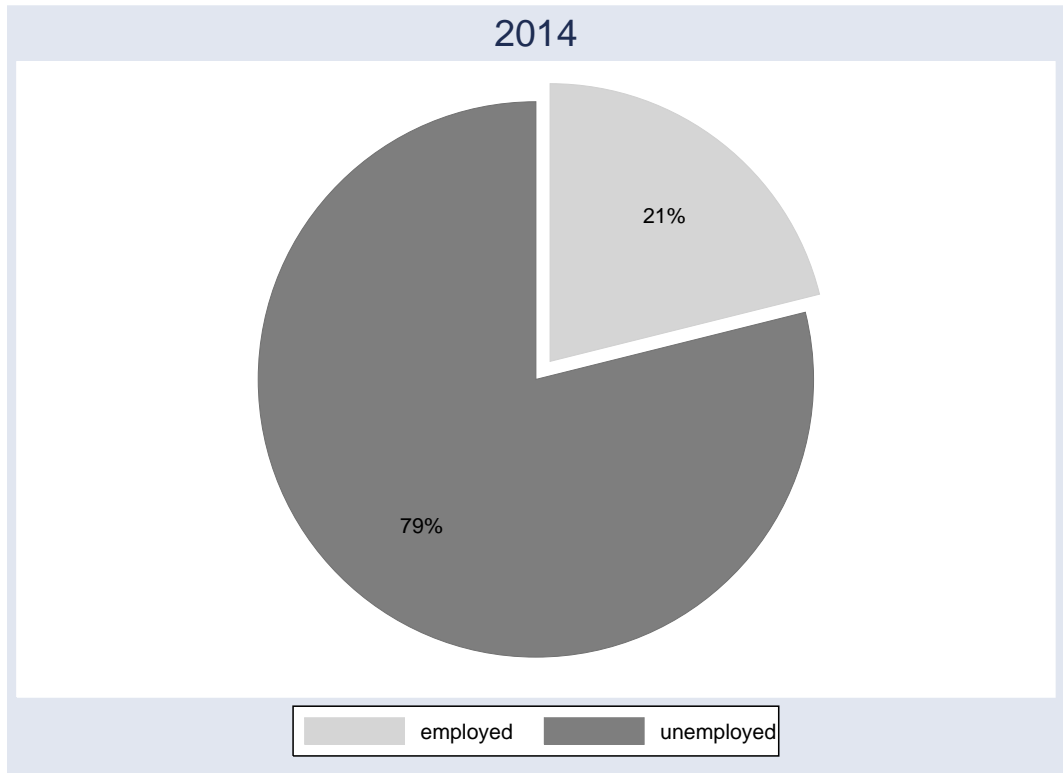


Figure 13: Incarceration History

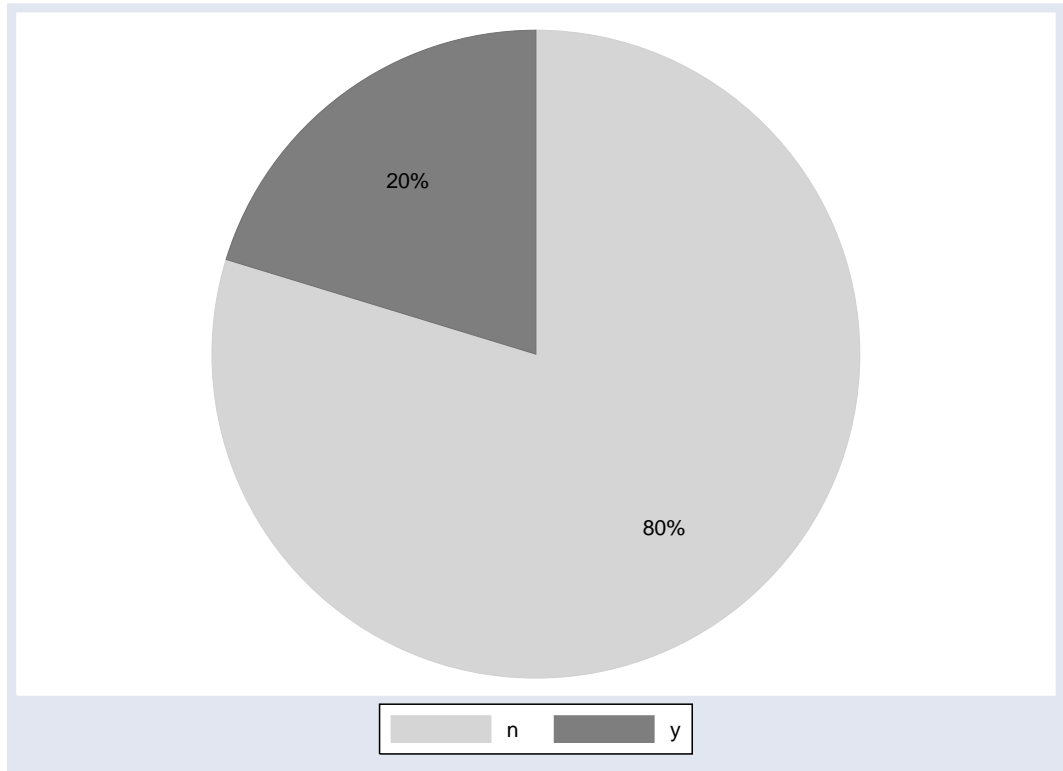
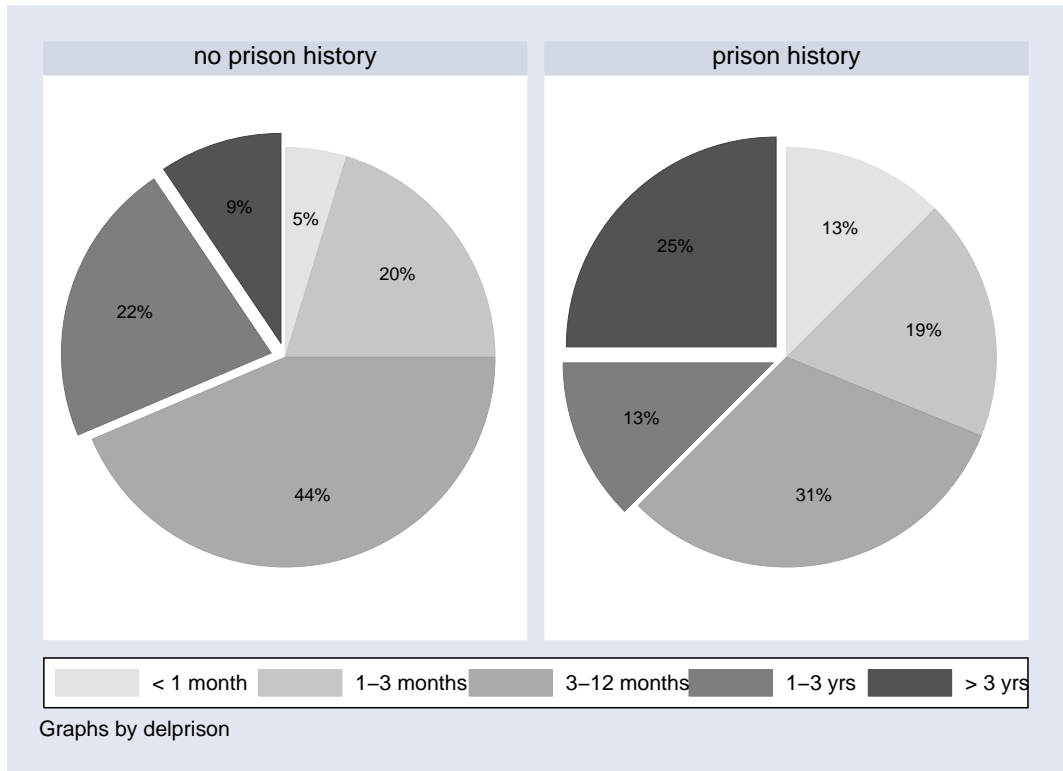
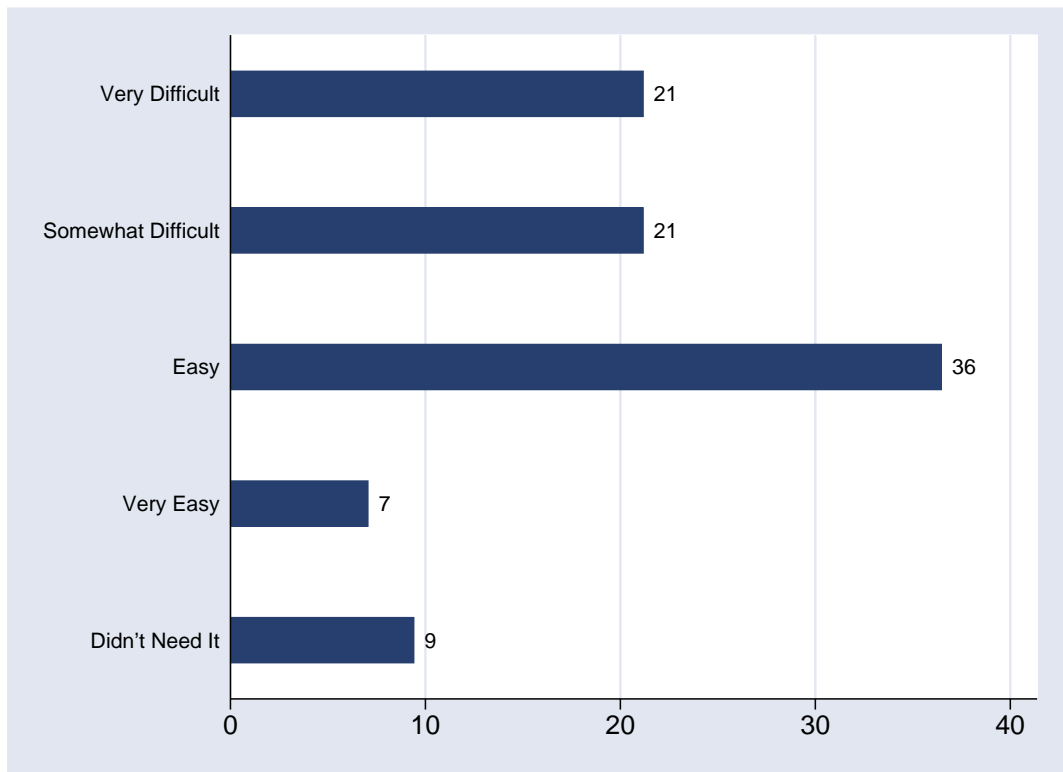


Figure 14: Incarceration & Homelessness



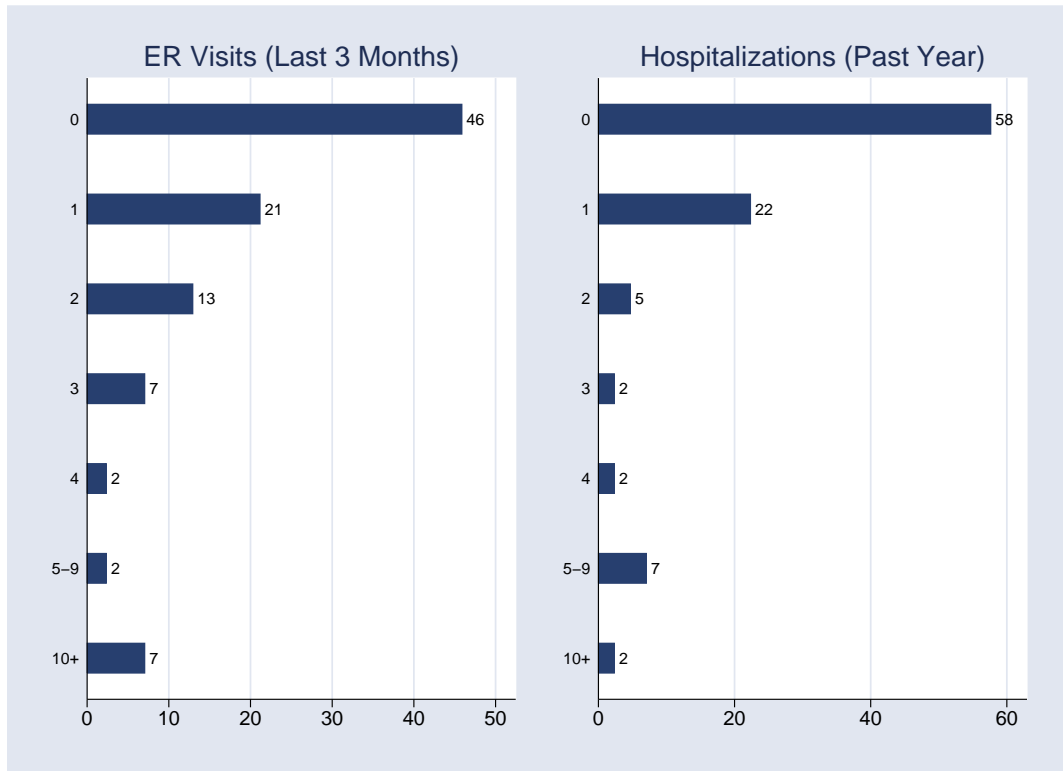

Figure 15: Ease of Getting Health Support



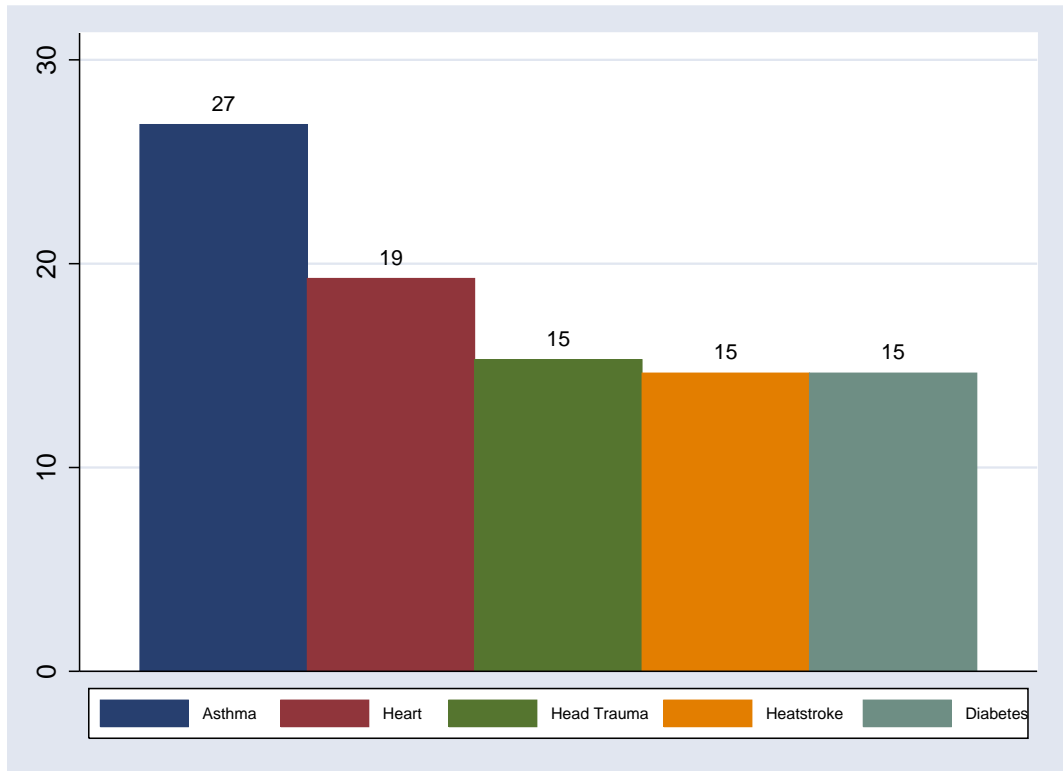

Figure 18: Treatment for Mental Health Illness

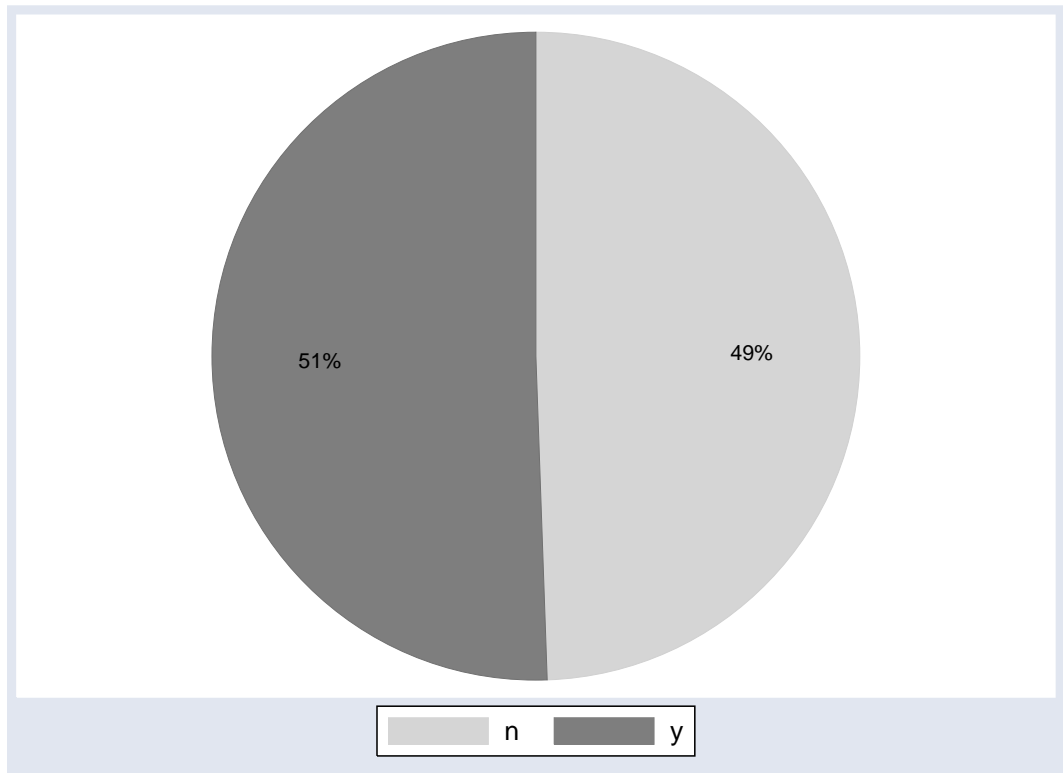
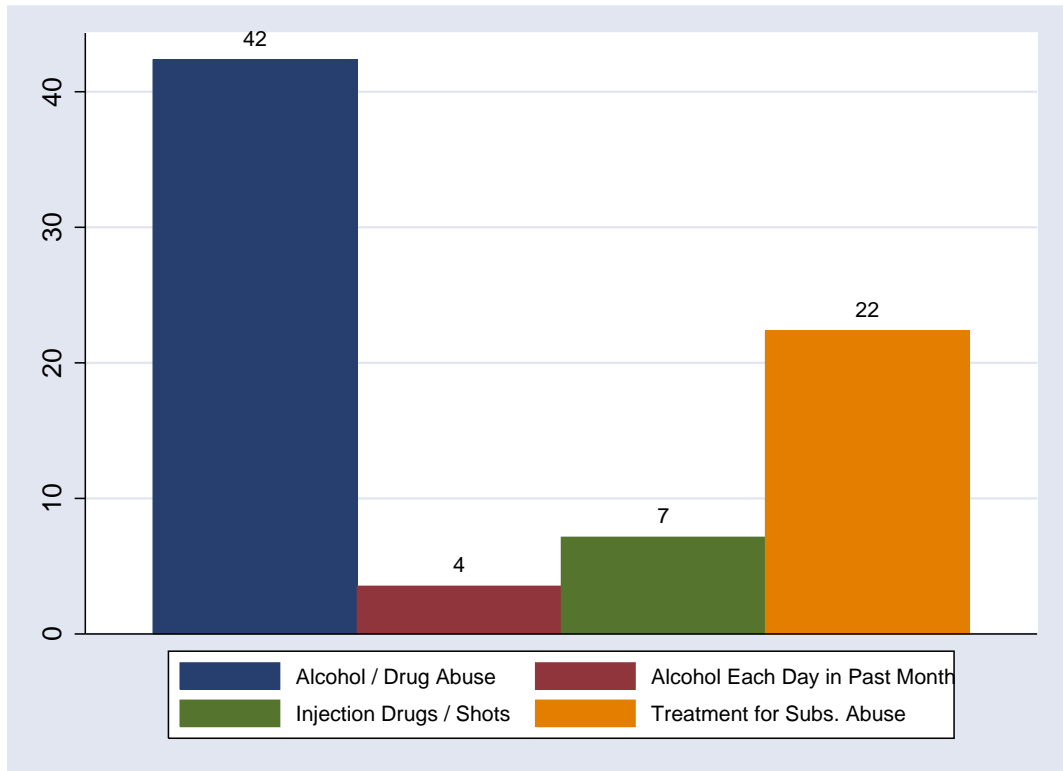


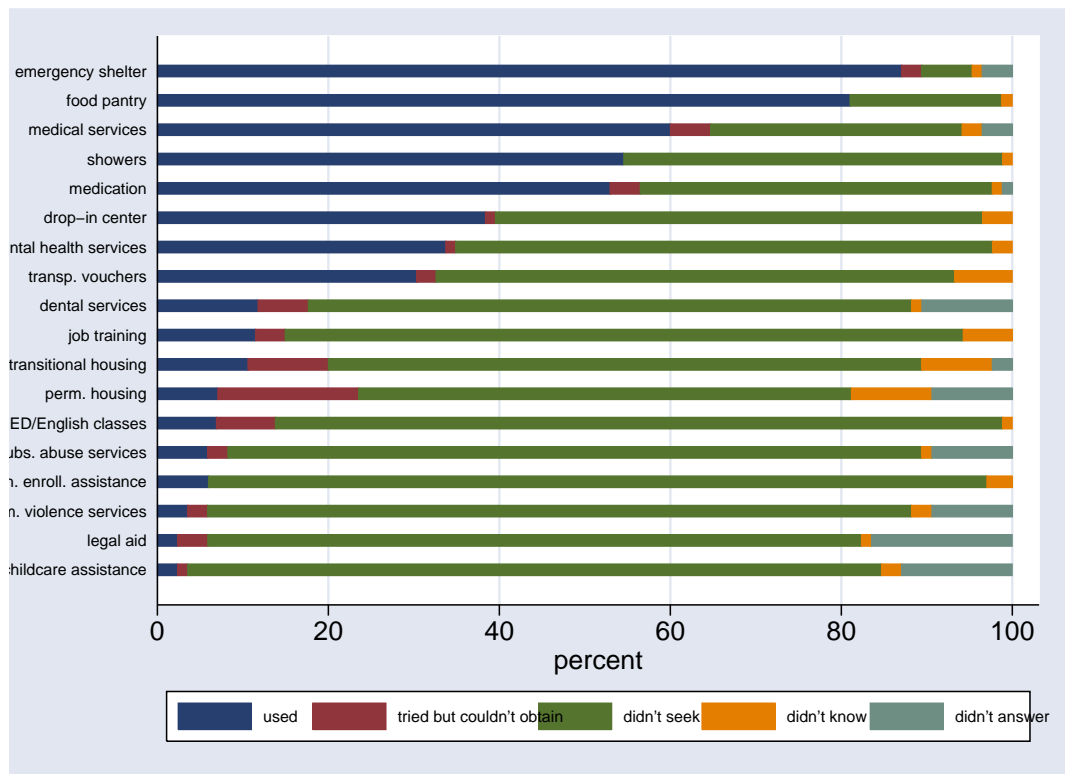
Figure 19: Substance Abuse

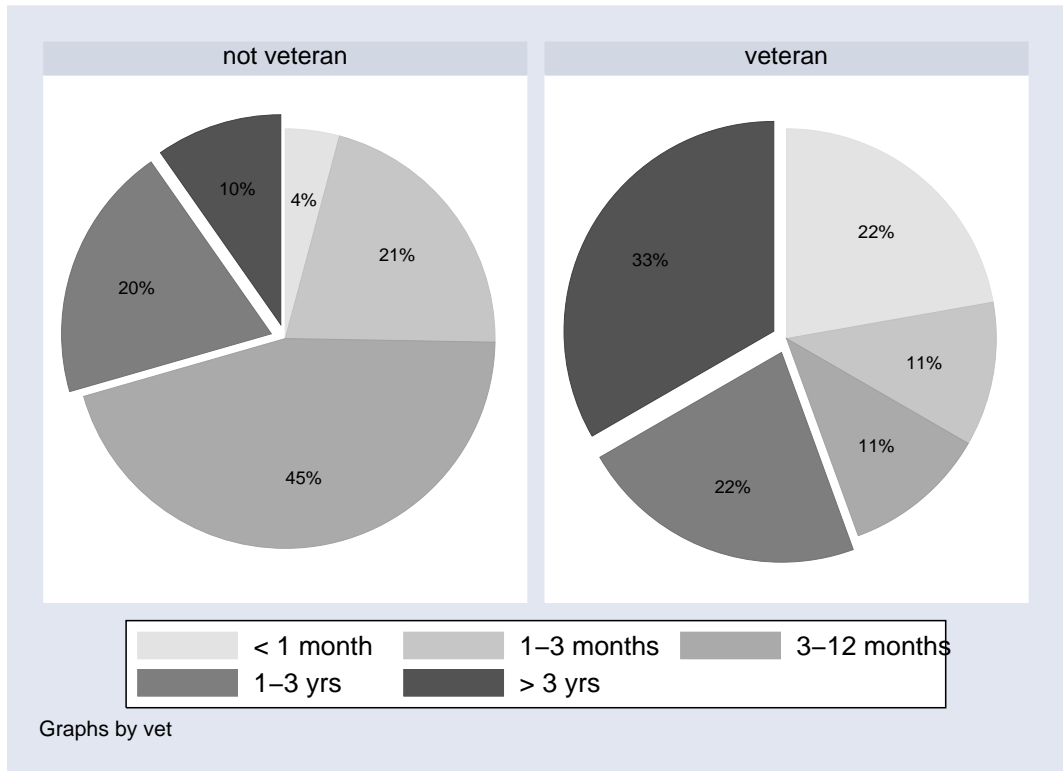
Figure 21: Incidence of Veterans

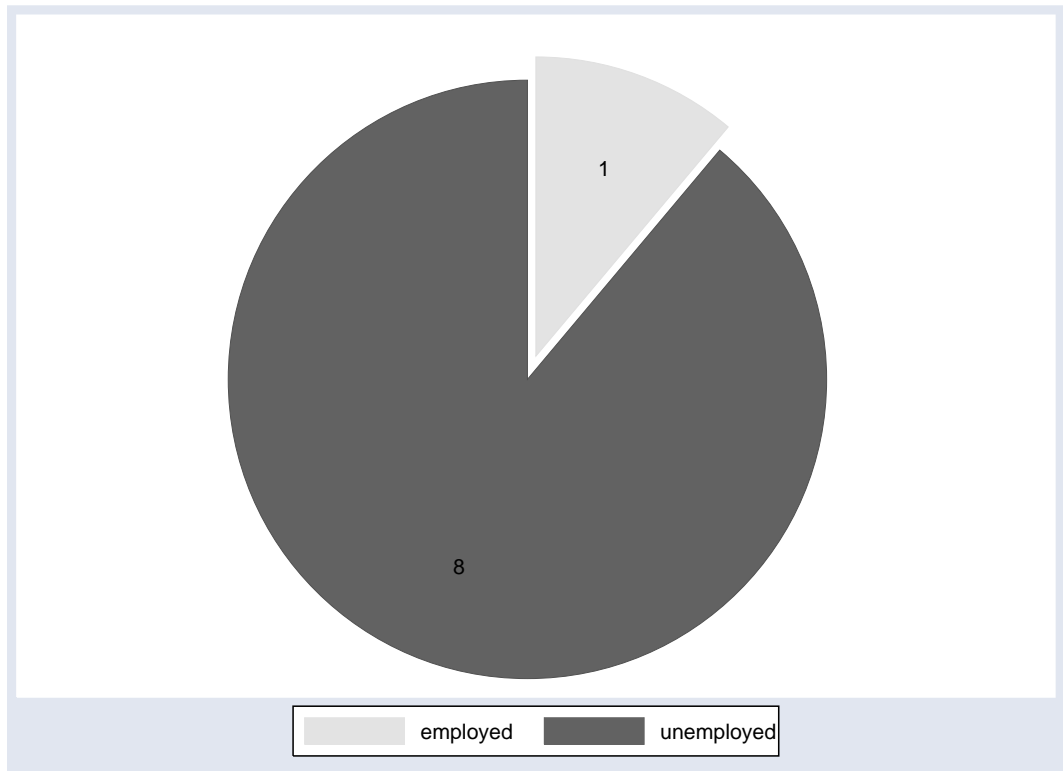
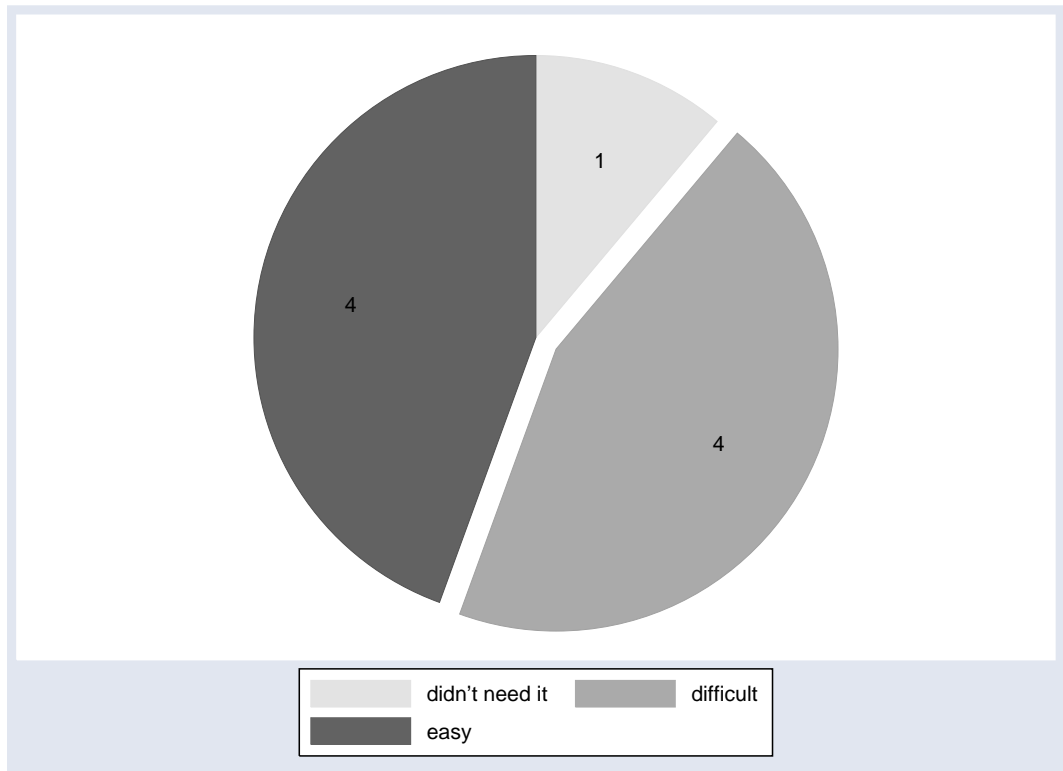


Figure 24: Homeless Veterans & Health Support

Figure 25: Homeless Veterans & Use of VA Hospitals

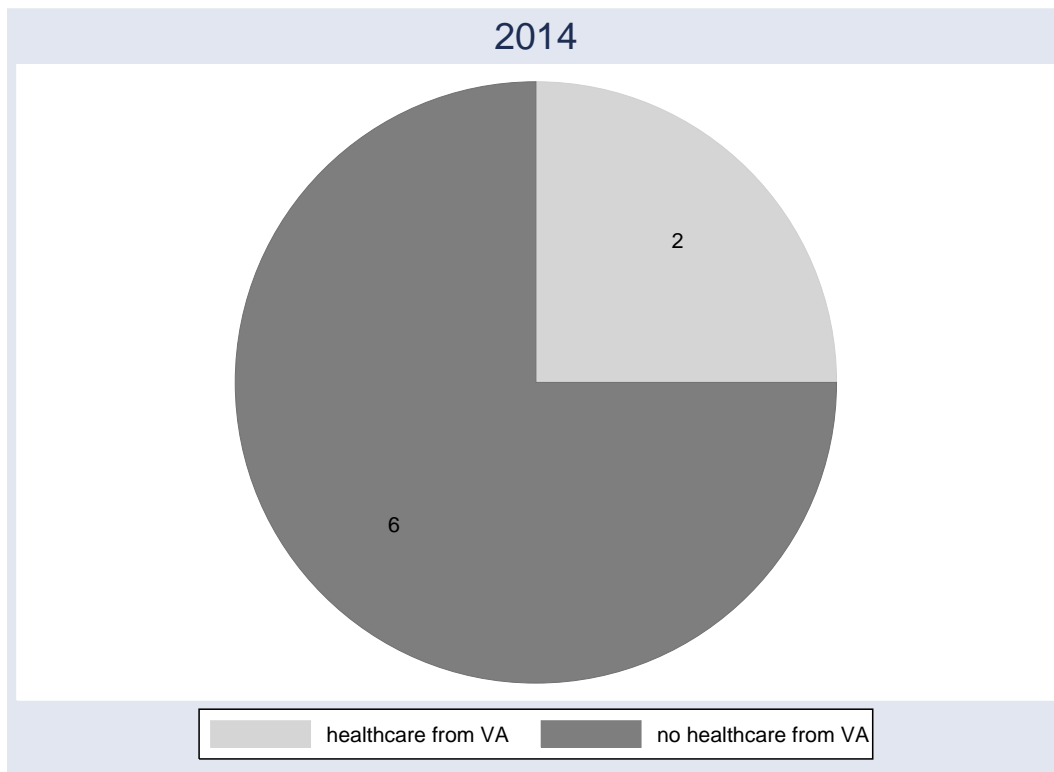
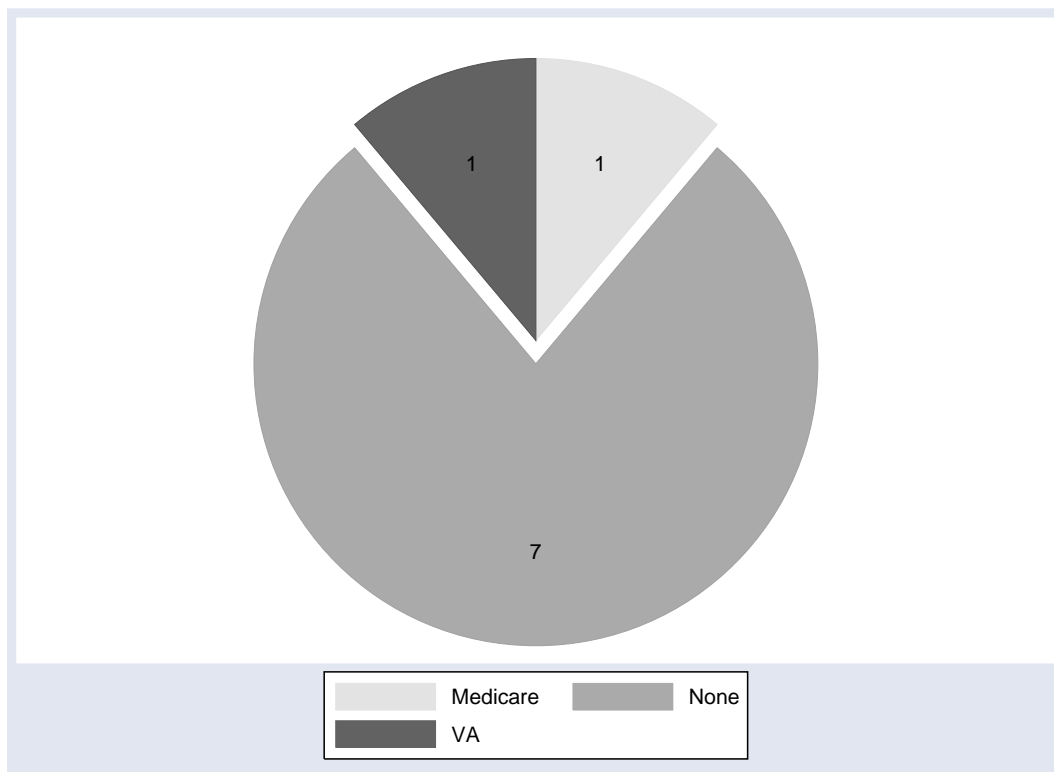


Figure 26: Homeless Veterans & Health Insurance
