

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON ENACTING
AN ORDINANCE TO PLACE RESTRICTIONS ON
PLACING COMBUSTIBLE LANDSCAPE COVER
(MULCH) WITHIN 18 INCHES OF BUILDINGS WITH
COMBUSTIBLE SIDING IN THE
CITY OF HARRISONBURG**

The Harrisonburg City Council will hold a public hearing **on March 24, 2015 at 7:00 P.M.**, or as soon as the agenda permits, in the City Council Chambers located at 409 South Main Street, Harrisonburg, Virginia, to solicit public comments concerning the consideration of amending Title 5, Chapter 2 enacting an ordinance prohibiting the placing of combustible landscape cover material (mulch) within 18 inches of buildings with combustible siding. The proposed prohibition will apply to all buildings except single family residences not used as adult care or child care facilities.

Copies of the proposed ordinances are available on the city's website and are available in the City Managers Office, 345 South Main Street, Harrisonburg, Virginia, Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P. M.

All persons interested will have an opportunity to express their views at this public hearing.

Any person requiring auxiliary aids, including signers, in connection with this public hearing shall notify the City Manager prior to the day of the hearing.
