Summary: Approval of business, professional and occupational license refund for 2024

Background: § 58.1-3981 of the Code of Virginia requires City Council approval of any refunds in excess of \$10,000. To provide Council with adequate information to determine approval while also maintaining confidentiality pursuant to Code of Virginia §58.1-3, the business name has been redacted on the Certificate of the Commissioner of the Revenue. The original version of the Commissioner's certification is on file in the Commissioner's office, protected by attorney-client privilege, and will be signed by the City Attorney and provided to the Treasurer following Council approval.

Key Issues:

TAXPAYER A filed a business license renewal form in 2024 with a check for the entire year. TAXPAYER A business changed ownership in Harrisonburg on April 8, 2024 and informed the Commissioner of the Revenue office May 21, 2024. The 2024 business license was prorated for four (4) months. Amount of refund: \$21,906.66, plus interest.

Environmental Impact: n/a

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: The city will refund the business license in the amount of \$21,906.66, plus interest as required by law.
