

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING
SECTION 13-1-69 – PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES NEAR
RESIDENCES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

That Section 13-1-69 be enacted as shown:

Sec. 13-1-69. - Parking of commercial vehicles near residences.

It shall be unlawful for the owner, operator or driver of any motor passenger bus, for-hire car, truck with a gross vehicle weight rating of ten thousand (10,000) pounds or greater, trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, dumpster or portable storage container to park such vehicle or to permit such vehicle to be parked or placed on any of the streets, alleys or other public ways in the city in front of or adjacent to any portion of any lot zoned residential, for a period longer than sixty (60) minutes; provided, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any trailer (including a travel trailer, recreational vehicle, and camper) while connected to a tow vehicle or actually engaged in loading or unloading. Any vehicle or trailer owned by the City of Harrisonburg and engaged in providing municipal services shall be exempt from this section.

[Additionally, the provisions of this section shall not apply to any dumpster or portable storage container displaying a permit issued by the Department of Public Works. No such permit shall be valid for more than 72 hours.](#)
