RE: CDBG Citizen Participation Plan Amendment

<u>Summary:</u> The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) has been amended to include the AFFH Final Rule requirements found at 24 CFR 91.105 and 24 CFR 5. These revisions reflect the City's requirement to prepare and submit an Assessment of Fair Housing no later than October 1, 2016. A Public Hearing was held on April 26th, followed by a ten day Public Comment Period to solicit residents' input.

Background:

The Assessment of Fair Housing replaces the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (the AI) and will assist in fulfilling the City's obligation to affirmatively further fair housing as it relates to the CDBG program.

Key Issues:

Other revisions were made to the Plan that specify how the City will develop, revise, amend, adopt and revise the documents required as an entitlement community designated by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).
