Remonstrators "Due Diligence Report"

Misleadingly presents a 1 star rating on the BBB site as a full accounting of our abilities — deliberately crops the screenshot to omit that the rating is based on just 14 reviews collected over 3 years and that Woda Cooper has a B+ rating from the agency

Our company manages over 14,000 units and houses over 30,000 people – 14 negative reviews constitutes $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of a percent

Presents multiple photos of active maintenance such as a temporary pump as issues of concern, rather than the reality that this is proactive and responsible care for these properties

Presented a room where trash is deposited after being placed in a trash chutes as poor maintenance or a health hazard, when in reality it is an intentional design feature

Repeatedly highlights salt deposits on masonry – which is a normal occurrence that has no health or safety implications – as an indictment of our capacity

Our portfolio is currently at 96% occupancy, a major indicator of the level of resident satisfaction

Conclusion

After roaming across at least half a dozen properties constituting more than 400 units, over 1,000 residents, and 30 acres of grounds, this "report" is reduced to a series of inaccuracies and deliberate misrepresentations

We proactively offered to conduct a virtual town hall meeting for concerned neighbors to hear and respond to concerns and were turned down

Woda Cooper is an industry leader because of the quality of our work, and we have been repeatedly recognized by our peers, local units of government, and state housing agencies
