Dear Mayor Reed:

The committee has reviewed all the Applications for Tax Exemptions and all the supporting documentation (IRS exemption, tax returns, articles of incorporation, and bylaws etc) for The Community Foundation of Harrisonburg and Rockingham, Journey Counseling Ministries Inc and Anicira Veterinary Center. The Community Foundation real estate property at the current tax rate of .85¢ per \$100 would generate \$5,681.40 of revenue in FY 19 and personal property at the current tax rate of \$2.12 per \$100 would generate \$ 996.08 of revenue in FY 19. The Journey Counseling Ministries Inc personal property at the current tax rate of \$2.12 per \$100 would generate \$96.63 of revenue in FY19. Anicira Veterinary Center personal property at the current tax rate of \$3.50 per \$100 would generate \$402.50 of revenue in FY 19. The committee recommends that City Council approve the request for exemption.
