Petition to Create a New Permit Parking Zone

Out of concern for the vehicular behaviors present on our street, the residents of the proposed permit parking zone identified below submit this petition to the City of Harrisonburg for active consideration of a residential permit parking zone as outlined in Sec 13-1-60 of the City Code. We understand that upon receipt of a valid (50% approval) petition, the Police Department will conduct a survey to determine that the street(s) of the defined residential zone is being used for parking by the operators of motor vehicles who are nonresidents of that residential zone and the average number of vehicles of that kind of parking in that residential zone is in excess of twenty-five (25) percent of the number of parking spaces on those streets. Upon completion of the aforesaid survey, the results shall be submitted to the City Manager for his recommendation to City Council. The City Council may at that time, adopt an ordinance designating the area as a permit parking zone.

We propose the following streets to be included in the permit parking zone:
