WHEREAS Public Safety TeleCommunicators of the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Emergency Communications Center have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS each Public Safety TeleCommunicator has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the City of Harrisonburg declares the week of April 9<sup>th</sup> through 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to be "National Public Safety TeleCommunications Week" in Harrisonburg, VA, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our City and citizens safe.
