RESOLUTION CONSIDERING VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FY2018 REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM APPLICATION

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Harrisonburg City Council held on Tuesday October 25, 2016, on a motion by $\underline{\textit{TCD BYRD}}$, seconded by $\underline{\textit{ABE SHEARER}}$, the following resolution was adopted by a vote of $\underline{\textit{5}}$ to $\underline{\textit{0}}$:
WHEREAS, the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL desires to submit an application for an allocation of funds of up to \$935,888 through the Virginia Department of Transportation Fiscal Year 2017-18, Revenue Sharing Program; and,
WHEREAS, \$935,888 of these funds are requested to fund
1. Grace Street Extension on the campus of James Madison University from the Burris Parking lot to Carrier Drive; and,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby supports this application for an allocation of \$935,888 through the Virginia Department of Transportation Revenue Sharing Program.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby ensures that the required 50% local match funds will be provided for any approved revenue sharing grants,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the HARRISONBURG CITY COUNCIL hereby grants authority for the City Manager to execute project administration agreements for any approved revenue sharing projects.
