Please tell us about yourself and why you want to serve.

Why are you interested in serving on a board or commission?

I have lived in Harrisonburg for ten years, not counting the years I spent as an undergraduate student at JMU, and have chosen to buy a home and raise my children here. It has become so apparent to me that our community relies on people stepping up and serving in various roles in order to make sure it's a community that serves everyone. I am interested in serving on the HRHA board because I care about this community and have the desire to see it continue to grow in ways that serve the diverse needs of our local residents. Additionally, I have learned so much in the last 6 and a half years at United Way, and want to utilize that knowledge to support decision-making that impacts the community as a whole.

What other interests or concerns do you have regarding the community?

I am concerned about the growth of the ALICE population, which is the term we use at United Way to describe households who are Asset Limited, Income Constrained, and Employed. These households are working but not able to afford basic necessities such as food, childcare, healthcare, etc., and are often reliant upon support from local non-profits or other subsidized programs. I have spent a good amount of my time at United Way talking with local employers who mainly employ this population about how challenging it can be to maintain a steady workforce when households are struggling to make ends meet because they are one emergency away from crisis. This concern has led me to a strong interest in how our city works to support this population and how decisions made at the local level can ensure the economic stability of our business community.

What relevant experience or education do you have to this board or commission?

I have been through the Chamber Leadership Program and the Chamber BOLD program, which both focus on local leadership in the community. Through these programs, I have learned how interconnected different aspects of our community are, which I think is an incredibly valuable perspective for a member of a city board. Also, I have learned so much about our community through my role at United Way which has given me a unique perspective on the intersection between our business community and nonprofit community. This role has also allowed me the opportunity to spend time with leaders of other communities to learn about how they interact and how their cities are run.
