ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE B - PRODUCE MARKET AT MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT, SECTION 15-5-41 THROUGH 15-5-46 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

That Chapter 5, Article B, Sections 15-5-41 through 15-5-46 be repealed in its entirety and reserved.

Sec. 15-5-41. Designation of area.

The chief of police shall mark off and designate a sufficient portion of such municipal parking lot as a market for the sale of farm produce.

Sec. 15-5-42. Permit; required; fee.

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, or offer for sale, farm produce in the market area of the municipal parking lot designated by the chief of police pursuant to section 15-5-41 without a permit from the chief of police. No charge shall be made for such permit.

Sec. 15-5-43. Same; grounds for suspension.

Upon conviction of the holder of a permit issued pursuant to section 15-5-42 of a violation of any provision of this article or of any rule or regulation promulgated pursuant to section 15-5-46, the district court shall have power to suspend such permit for a period not to exceed six (6) months, which suspension shall be in addition to any penalty that may be imposed.

Sec. 15-5-44. Sales limited to farm products grown or produced by seller.

The market area in the municipal parking lot, designated by the chief of police pursuant to section 15-5-11 shall be used only for the sale or offering for sale of farm products grown or produced by the person so selling or offering for sale such farm products.

Sec. 15-5-45. Sanitary condition of area; removal of rubbish and waste.

The market area in the municipal parking lot designated by the chief of police pursuant to section 15-5-41 shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition by the users. Each holder of a permit issued pursuant to section 15-5-42 shall remove his own rubbish and waste.

Sec. 15-5-46. Sanitary rules and regulations.

The use of the market area of the municipal parking lot designated by the chief of police pursuant to section 15-5-41 shall be subject to such rules and regulations relative to sanitation as may be promulgated by the health officer. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to comply with such rules and regulations.
