RE: Waterline Easement to Jacktown Holdings, LLC

<u>Summary:</u> Grant an easement for a waterline across public lands of the City of Harrisonburg to serve a sprinkler system on property owned by Jacktown Holdings, LLC located at 92 South Main Street, Harrisonburg.

Background: 92 South Main Street currently is occupied by Billy Jack's Restaurant on the first floor and The Hideaway on the second floor. Recently the City's Department of Community Development and the Fire Department informed Jacktown Holdings, LLC that The Hideaway required a sprinkler system. Jacktown Holdings, LLC would like to upgrade the sprinkler system in Billy Jack's and add a sprinkler system in The Hideaway. This would require running a private waterline from the City's existing waterline located in the alley just to the north of Jack Browns, across the City's Newman Avenue parking lot to the property at 92 South Main Street. The plans for this waterline have been approved by the City's Department of Public Utilities and Department of Public Works. Under state law, the easement can only be granted for up to 40 years.
