of children in Virginia

54% (14,371)

of children in Harrisonburg & Rockingham County







Hardship's Disproportionate Impact

In Harrisonburg City & Rockingham County...

**COMPARE:** 

47% of children in VA 54% of children in Harrisonburg City & Rockingham County live below the ALICE Threshold

67% of Black children 69% of Hispanic children



36% of White children

... are part of families living below the ALICE Threshold in financially insecure households





Children by age in Harrisonburg City & Rockingham County...

61% Infants (0-2 yrs)

77% Pre-school age (3-4 yrs)

49% School age (5-17 yrs)

...are living below the ALICE Threshold in households unable to make ends meet.

Hardship's Disproportionate Impact

In Virginia...

59% of families with a child with a disability

84% of children live in households with limited English spoken in the home

...are living below the ALICE Threshold, one crisis away from financial disaster.

Hardship's Disproportionate Impact

White children: 65%

Black children: 81%

Hispanic children: 86%

Are part of families living in **rental housing** in Harrisonburg City & Rockingham County living below the ALICE Threshold, surviving paycheck to paycheck with no savings.

Hardship's Disproportionate Impact

White children: 65%

Black children: 81%

Hispanic children: 86%

Are part of families living in **rental housing** in Harrisonburg City & Rockingham County with income below the ALICE Threshold.

**75%** of children in Virginia are part of households living in rental housing with income that falls below the AT

**99%** of children in Virginia are living in rent-burdened households (+30% of income goes to housing)

# Working, But Still Struggling

Of Harrisonburg & Rockingham households with...

TWO working adults, 31% of children

ONE working adult, 67% of children

...are living below the ALICE Threshold and don't earn enough to save for an emergency.





## ALICE Children During the Pandemic


### COVID hit ALICE harder. . .

- COVID health risks to children
- Covering added cost of child care during shutdowns
- Increased costs when home more food, utilities, water
- Increased stress, strain and mental health issues






