ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 13-4-3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

That Section 13-4-3. Composition, appointment, terms and removal of members.

The commission shall consist of a total of seven (7) members, five (5) of whom shall be citizens of the city and shall be appointed at large by the city council to represent various geographic areas of the city. The remaining two (2) members of the commission shall be the chief of police or his designee and the street superintendent or his designee. The terms of the appointed members shall be for three (3) years and such terms shall be staggered in a 2-2-1 format, with two members of the commission coming up for appointment every first and second year and one member of the commission coming up for appointment every third year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms. The city council may remove any appointed member at any time and appoint his or her successor.

The commission may choose to request the regular attendance of meetings by representatives from community stakeholder groups. These representatives shall be considered non-voting participants that serve the commission in an advisory capacity. Representatives from the following stakeholder organizations should be considered for this designation: Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles, Harrisonburg Fire Department, Harrisonburg Department of Public Transportation, James Madison University and Eastern Mennonite University.

The remainder of Chapter 4. Harrisonburg Transportation Safety and Advisory Commission is reaffirmed and reenacted in its entirety except as hereby modified.

This ordinance shall be effective from the <u>September 9, 2014</u>. Adopted and approved this <u>9</u> day of <u>September, 2014</u>.
