# Tap grant safe routes to school

## Safe Routes to School History

- **VDOT Funding with Sentara**
  - Ended in 2021
- **VDOT Funding with Harrisonburg**
  - Program Restarted 2024
  - Hired Andrea Troyer



# Tap grant safe routes to school

## Achievements

- Met with School Administration to reintroduce the SRTS Program
- Completed Education Sessions at Smithland, Stone Spring, Bluestone, and Thomas Harrison. 311 Instructional Hours
- Maintained bikes at 6 Schools. 54 hours of maintenance performed
- Met with all PE Teachers and working to develop Educational Plans
- Purchased 20 new bikes for Rocktown
- Bike Lessons with Parks & Rec. 25 individuals, ages 5-9.
- Bike/Walk/Roll Day 2025. 200+ students and 40+ staff participated.
- Created "Recommended Routes for Biking and Walking to School" webpage
- Created information flyers in English, Spanish, Arabic, and Kurdish



# Tap grant safe routes to school

## Program Grant Request

- TAP Funding – Years 1 & 2
  - Program Cost = \$150,000
  - Eligible Cost = \$90,000
    - TAP Funding = \$72,000
    - City Funding = \$78,000
- TAP Funding – Years 3 & 4
  - Program Cost = \$150,000
  - Eligible Cost = \$45,000
    - TAP Funding = \$36,000
    - City Funding = \$114,000
