RE: Supplemental Appropriation – Various Department Grants and Reimbursements

Summary: Consider a supplemental appropriation for various departments.

Background: Several departments have been awarded various grants and reimbursements throughout the course of the current fiscal year. This supplemental appropriation also includes using a portion of the speed camera revenue that the City has received this fiscal year. This request will appropriate these funds into the respective department budgets.

Key Issues:

- The City has received speed camera revenue throughout the fiscal year. \$466,000 of these funds will be used to purchase barricades by the Public Works Department for downtown events.
- VDOT is providing an additional \$905,046 to the city from its highway maintenance funds. These funds will primarily be used to replace the traffic signal at E. Market St. and Reservoir St.
- The Police Department was awarded a total of \$26,995 from DMV Grants for alcohol, speed and pedestrian/bicycle selective enforcement and \$108,000 from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services through its Community Hate Crime Program.
- The Fire Department was awarded Homeland Security Program Grants for the hazardous materials and tactical rescue teams in the amount of \$115,140.
- Tourism was awarded \$20,000 in marketing grant funds from the Virginia Tourism Corporation.
- Parks & Recreation received donations from the Harrisonburg Little League in the amount of \$33,364 for the purchase of a scoreboard and a shed.

Fiscal Impact: This action will increase the General Fund budget by \$1,676,045.
