RE: Enacting Section 6-1-27 Crossing Intersections diagonally

Summary: Enact new Section 6-1-27 which permits crossing intersections diagonally under certain circumstances.

Background: The City has several intersections, mostly around the JMU area, such as Grace Street and South Main, at which pedestrians are permitted to cross the intersection diagonally. Under Virginia Code Section 46.2-923, in order to permit such diagonal crossings, the governing body of the locality must specifically provide for such crossings. The new Section 6-1-27 follows the language contained in state law and permits pedestrians to cross an intersection diagonally when all traffic entering the intersection has been halted by lights, other traffic control devises, or by a law enforcement officer.

Key Issues: Permit pedestrians to cross intersections diagonally under certain circumstances.
