RE: Proposed Amendments to Title 7, Chapter 3 of the City Code

<u>Summary:</u> Proposed Amendments to Title 7, Chapter 3 of the City Code, "Sewer System," at the request of the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Regional Sewer Authority.

Background:

At its June 7, 2021 meeting, the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Regional Sewer Authority approved revisions to the HRRSA's Operating Rules and Regulations. These revisions were mandated by Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) based on the United States EPA's Streamlining Regulations.

DEQ has reviewed and accepted the amendments to HRRSA's Operating Rules and Regulations.

Key Issues:

Pursuant to the City's Interjurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement, HRRSA from time-to-time requests each participating jurisdiction amend its local ordinances to ensure consistency between HRRSA's Operating Rules and Regulations and the participating jurisdictions.

HRRSA has requested these amendments be adopted no later than September 1, 2021.
