RE: Ordinance confirming, readopting, and continuing the Emergency Ordinance adopted on April

6, 2020

<u>Summary:</u> Consider confirming, readopting, and continuing the Emergency Ordinance adopted on April 6, 2020 and the associated temporary changes in deadlines and modifications to public meeting and public hearing practices and procedures to address continuity of operations associated with COVID-19.

<u>Background:</u> On April 6, 2020, City Council adopted an emergency ordinance that addressed changes to deadlines, modifications to public meetings and public hearings, and other city practices. City Council confirmed, readopted, and continued the emergency ordinance on September 8, 2020. State Code requires that such emergency ordinances expire if not renewed from time to time by the governing body.

<u>Key Issues:</u> If not confirmed, readopted, and continued, the Emergency Ordinance will expire March 8, 2021.
