# Interests & Experiences

Please tell us about yourself and why you want to serve.

### Why are you interested in serving on a board or commission?

I am interested in serving on the Public Tree Advisory Board because, as a citizen, I am want to support Harrisonburg's efforts to restore and maintain its tree canopy. I support its urban forestry program, urban wood program, and Tree City USA designation. Healthy trees are a key to any inviting, livable city. They promote the health and well-being of people. Trees also mitigate heat, which is increasingly important as the climate warms. Trees filter water, helping to protect Blacks Run and the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. Native trees also host large numbers of insect species that are necessary to animal life and to protecting biodiversity. Harrisonburg has been my home for nearly 30 years. It is where we raised our children, and we plan to retire here. As I begin to ponder my retirement, I want to start giving back to the community and work on behalf of environmental conservation and sustainability. One immediate reason for my applying now is a recent conversation with Jeremy Harold, Harrisonburg's green space manager, who mentioned that the citizen positions on the Tree Board will soon be open. He encouraged me to apply.

#### What other interests or concerns do you have regarding the community?

I am interested in all efforts on the part of the City to become more sustainable. I am interested in the City's pollinator program and efforts to restore Blacks Run. These efforts benefit City residents as well as nature, which we rely on. I am also interested in the arts, affordable housing, education, and finding common ground among people rather than creating or exacerbating divisions among people in this very polarized political climate. I am interested in Harrisonburg remaining a welcoming place for everyone.

### What relevant experience or education do you have to this board or commission?

I completed the Virginia Master Naturalist training program this year (2023) and expect to become a Certified Virginia Master Naturalist after completing the requisite volunteer and continuing education hours during 2024. In addition, I have a long-standing interest in landscape, land use, and place that is part of my practice as a photographer and artist. For example, In 1999 I published Blacks Run: An American Stream (Harrisonburg: Center for American Places), a small book of original photographs and excerpts from interviews with community activists, local historians, and city officials as a means of creating a "community conversation along Blacks Run" that would help diverse groups find common ground about how best to manage and restore Blacks Run.

Please list any past or present community involvement e.g. City Council, Boards and Commissions, Citizen Academy, etc. in Harrisonburg or elsewhere:

I have not previously served on a City-related board. However, from approximately 1999 until 2003, I served along with other Harrisonburg citizens and City staff as part of a public-private partnership to develop a Blacks Run Greenway. These efforts culminated with hiring a planning consultant and creating the Blacks Run Greenway Master Plan (https://www.harrisonburgva.gov/blacks-run-greenway-plan). I also served on the Board of Directors of the Arts Council of the Valley in Harrisonburg from 2009-2010, and as Board Secretary and Executive Committee member from 2010-2014.
